Attached is the summary of the internal affairs investigation. I've also included below the summaries of internal affairs histories for Lunn and O'Brien.

Lunn:

SR2012 Jail 04 The allegation of a relationship with the public violation was substantiated which resulted in a performance agreement.

IA2013-02 The allegation of excessive use of force by several deputies, including Deputy Lunn, was unfounded. No discipline.

IA2016-18 The allegation of excessive use of force by Deputy Lunn was substantiated resulting in a Letter of Reprimand.

AR2018-19 The accident review found Deputy Lunn at fault, accident preventable. A performance notation was placed in the working file, but no discipline.

AR2018-23 The accident review found Deputy Lunn at fault, accident preventable. A performance notation was placed in the working file, but no discipline.

IA2018-46 The allegation of policy violations that caused a death were substantiated resulting in termination. A separate investigation resulted in criminal charges. A summary of the internal affairs investigation is attached.

O'Brien:

IA2002-04 The allegation of accessing CCIC/NCIC records for personal purposes was substantiated. One other deputy was involved.

IA2004-14 The allegation of pushing in inmate was substantiated resulting in a Letter of Reprimand.

IA2010-05 The allegation of egregious professional conduct violations that resulted in questionable credibility during a court testimony was substantiated. Deputy O'Brien was reassigned from the Operations Division to the Jail Division.

SR2016-11 The allegation of a relationship with the public violation was inconclusive. No discipline.

SR2016-41 The allegation of a relationship with the public violation was unfounded. No discipline.

SR2017-6 The allegation of a timekeeping violation was substantiated resulting in a probationary status for extra duty assignments.

IA2018-46 The allegation of policy violations that caused a death were substantiated resulting in termination. A separate investigation resulted in criminal charges. A summary of the internal affairs investigation is attached.
