## NEWS RELEASE

### Former Police Officer Arrested, Faces Multiple Charges

**December 21, 2022 – Cripple Creek, CO** – A comprehensive investigation culminated in an arrest warrant being issued for former Cripple Creek Police Department Detective/Sergeant Alexander Kenoyer on December 19, 2022.

Kenoyer (DOB: 08/07/1986) faces charges of Unlawful Sexual Conduct by a Peace Officer – Intrusion or Penetration – While on Duty (Class 3 Felony), Unlawful Sexual Conduct by a Peace Officer – Contact – While on Duty (Class 4 Felony) and Attempt to Influence a Public Servant (Class 4 Felony).

Cripple Creek Police Chief Charles Bright requested the investigative assistance of the Colorado Bureau of Investigation based on allegations made by a citizen as part of an Internal Affairs investigation initiated by the department on August 20, 2022.

The charges stem from an alleged inappropriate sexual relationship with a victim of an alleged crime the sergeant investigated as a member of the Cripple Creek Police Department beginning in October 2021.

Kenoyer was placed on Administrative Leave on August 24, 2022; he resigned from the Cripple Creek Police Department on October 25, 2022.

He turned himself in to police on December 19, 2022. His advisement in the 4th Judicial District Court occurred on December 20, 2022. Kenoyer was released on \$10,000 bond.

Due to the sensitive nature of the charges, and consideration of the victim, details about this case are not available at this time.
