RE: Revocation of Appointment/Termination of Employment

This document concerns your employment with the Larimer County Sheriff's Office; please read it carefully.

This letter is based on Larimer County Sheriff's Office Internal Affairs Investigation IA2026-00004 that was opened on January 23, 2026, to investigate allegations regarding your truthfulness, duty responsibilities, false reporting, and failure to comply with Housing Post Orders.

The Professional Standards investigation focused on three policy violations:

1. **LCSO Policy 10000.2.8 (Truthfulness):** *You knowingly made false representations and were not truthful when making reports in the Jail Management System.*
2. **LCSO Policy 10000.3.1 (Duty Responsibilities):** *You knowingly failed to perform your duties as required by policies, procedures, or post orders.*
3. **LCSO Policy 10000.4.8 (False Report):** *You knowingly created status check events and logged cell searches in the system to indicate checks and searches were performed when, in fact, they were not. These entries were falsified and did not meet policy requirements.*

All three violations were found to be *Improper Conduct* following the investigation.

I've had the opportunity to read and review IA2026-00004 in its entirety and to meet with you during your appeal of the disciplinary decision. While you were provided multiple opportunities to provide additional information or mitigating circumstances, you stated you had nothing additional to add. However, I do appreciate you and your attorney attending.

The investigative record makes it evident that the public trust was violated and the safety of those in our care was endangered by your actions. Therefore, based on my review of the documentation available to me, it is my determination that your appointment as a deputy and your employment with the Larimer County Sheriff's Office be terminated, effective immediately

The findings of Improper Conduct involve untruthfulness and the falsification of reports, thus this matter constitutes a decertifying basis under Colorado law. Pursuant to C.R.S. 24-31-305(2.5), this outcome will be reported to the Colorado Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Board and the District Attorney's Office for the 8th Judicial District.
