1. Anderson, Christian 2312 a peace officer with the Parker Police Department state that there exist probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named suspect for the charges stated above. The officer further states that the facts below are based on personal knowledge and/ or interviews with the witnesses and fellow peace officers and/ or review of law enforcement reports.

1. The Crime(s) alleged occurred on 2/7/2026

at Jordan Road and Bradbury Parkway

2. City of PARKER , County of DOUGLAS , State of Colorado

3. The facts in support of the probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above name suspect are as follows:

PROBABLE CAUSE

On February 7, 2026 at approximately 1952 hours Sergeant D. Kavalec of the Parker Police Department, was driving southbound on Jordan Road north of Mainstreet in the Town of Parker, County of Douglas, State of Colorado, when she observed a blue Chevrolet truck, bearing Colorado license plates DWL-K30, traveling in the number 2 southbound lane. Sergeant Kavalec observed the truck swerve from the number two lane into the number 1 southbound lane and back. As the truck approached the light at Mainstreet, Sergeant Kavalec observed the truck enter into the westbound turn lane to Mainstreet and then back into the number 2 southbound lane of traffic before stopping at the red light at Mainstreet.

As the light turned green and the truck continued southbound, it failed to maintain its lane and the driver's side entered into the number 1 lane of traffic before returning to the number 2 lane. Sergeant Kavalec activated her lights for a traffic stop and the truck was slow to stop, eventually stopping near Bradbury Parkway and Hitching Post Circle in the Town of Parker.

Sergeant Kavalec approached the passenger side of the truck and observed the driver digging through his wallet. The driver, and sole occupant, looked at her on the passenger side and did not roll down his window or acknowledge her. Sergeant Kavalec walked around the truck to the driver's side where the driver, identified by his Colorado Driver's license as

Handed her his driver's license and a credit card. Andrew would not make eye contact with Sergeant Kavalec and continued to stare forward while she asked him questions. Sergeant Kavalec asked Andrew where he was coming from and he stated a daddy daughter dance. Sergeant Kavalec observed he had a bag of Taco Bell on his passenger seat and no child in the vehicle. Sergeant Kavalec asked Andrew for his registration and insurance and he opened the glove compartment and then stopped looking when she asked a divided attention question. While answering questions, Sergeant Kavalec observed Andrew to be speaking with a thick tongue. Officer Anderson arrived on scene and took over the investigation.

Officer Anderson asked Andrew to step outside of the vehicle to which he cooperated and exited the vehicle. While exiting the vehicle, Andrew stumbled slightly while walking over to the sidewalk. After walking to the sidewalk and standing, it was observed that his eyes were glassy. When he spoke, Officer Anderson observed that his speech was slurred and very slow.

Officer Anderson asked Andrew if he would be willing to conduct a series of voluntary roadside maneuvers to which he immediately refused roadsides. He was asked multiple times by Officer Anderson and each time he refused the roadside maneuvers. Due to the observations of Sergeant Kavalec prior to stopping the vehicle Andrew was taken into custody and placed in the back of a patrol vehicle. When placed in the back of a patrol vehicle, Andrew was read Colorado Expressed Consent with a department issued card. Andrew stated that he didn't understand and it was read again to him to which he gave the same statement that he didn't understand. It was clarified once more that he was required to submit to a blood or breath test to which once more stated he didn't understand the question. After two more requests, his refusal to answer the question was taken as a refusal to submit to chemical testing. While inside the back of the patrol vehicle, Officer Anderson could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from Andrew and the back of the patrol unit.

Andrew was then transported to Skyridge South Parker located at 12223 Pine Bluffs Way in the Town of Parker, County of Douglas, State of Colorado to obtain a blood draw and apply for a warrant. A warrant was applied for and sent to the 23rd Judicial District District Attorney's Office. It was signed by Judge Kelly Waidler of the 23rd Judicial District on February 7, 2026 at 2230 hours.

Andrew was shown the signed search warrant for his blood and repeatedly stated that he did not consent to a blood draw despite the warrant. Officers had to restrain his arm and a blood draw was conducted on his left arm by Skyridge South Parker staff at approximately 2244 hours. Due to the physical resistance from Andrew while attempting the blood draw, he was charged with obstructing a peace officer. While waiting for Officers to respond to transport him to jail, Officer Terry stated that Andrew spit on her while in the emergency room. Officer Terry stated that she was sitting on the bench in front of Andrew while he was on the bed and she checked her watch. She stated Andrew then stated, "Yeah look at your watch bitch," and then proceeded to spit at her. Due to those actions he was charged with assault in the third degree. Andrew was then taken to Arapahoe County Jail and transferred to their jail staff. Nothing further.
