Summary:

Complainant called the Falcon Substation to complain about a contact that the involved officer had with him. The officer went to complainant's residence to follow up on a traffic complaint from CSFD. Complainant claimed that officers "pounded" on the front door to his residence and then

seconds later 'pounded' on the nearby bedroom window, without giving the complainant time to answer the door. Complainant also said that when he was talking to the officer, the officer was rude unprofessional in the way that he spoke to the complainant, and the complainant did not think it was appropriate for the officer to contact him as part of the investigation. During a follow up phone call with complainant, he was upset that his girlfriend received a traffic ticket and he did not think there was probable cause of the citation.
