Summary:

On 6-5-19 I was advised by PSR K. Moore that a [REDACTED] had called in with a concern about a keep the peace that occurred at her apartment today [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is a victim of CSPD Case Report [REDACTED] (Attempted Second Degree Murder) and the suspect was a [REDACTED] DOB 3-16-95. [REDACTED] advised that she had changed her locks between the time of the event and today's date and that [REDACTED] does not have a key. [REDACTED] stated that she was not present during the keep the peace nor was she notified about the keep the peace occurring. Furthermore, [REDACTED] received a voicemail message from the maintenance supervisor, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised a male officer told [REDACTED] that the Officer was in possession of a court order to complete this keep the peace and the Officer would break the door down. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that he then told the male officer he was not comfortable with unlocking the door since [REDACTED] was not on the lease, [REDACTED] was not present, and the locks had recently been changed. However, when the male Officer threatened to force entry into the apartment he acquiesced. [REDACTED] was not made aware of this action prior to nor was she contacted by Officers afterwards. She will examine her apartment to ensure only [REDACTED] property was taken. In the CFS today the clearing comments are, "Upon arrival locks had been changed. Contacted maintenance person who responded and unlocked door to facilitate KTP. No problems encountered. BWC. APT relocked and key returned to maintenance." Next, I briefly reviewed the BWC for [REDACTED]. In this footage, it is clear [REDACTED] has several other male parties helping him gather up items. However, it is clear in the footage that [REDACTED] is not present. Officer Brian Uebelhoer 1769 BWC had not uploaded to the system where I could review it.
