Incident Summary: RP called in to report possible unprofessional conduct by Sgt. Gallegos who was conducting handicapped placard checks at King Soopers. RP alleged that Sgt. Gallegos was unprofessional and rude when speaking to her daughter about the misuse of her mother's handicapped placard. RP stated that Sgt. Gallegos refused to allow her daughter to explain that her grandmother was waiting for her at Subway which is in the King Soopers parking lot. RP stated without much explanation Sgt. Gallegos seized her mother's placard.			
I reviewed the BWC regarding this incident and found that Sgt. Gallegos had seized 4 handicapped placards during this incident. Three were expired and did not belong to anyone in the vehicle. RP's daughter was alone and never mentioned once that she was with her grandmother or that her grandmother was waiting for her at an establishment in the same parking lot. Sgt. Gallegos was professional and informative during his contact with RP daughters, even opting to seize the placard instead of citing her for the violation. I found no unprofessional behavior by Sgt. Gallegos during this contact.			
RP was advised of my findings and invited to review BWC if necessary. RP stated they were satisfied with the results and made no further requests.
