Incident Summary

Notes: AIM Notes 1/27/2022, restraint chairs arrived at the warehouse of the Detention Facility from a proposal written by [REDACTED]. In communicating with the restraint chair company, Safety Restraint Chair Inc., the company representative, [REDACTED] made it very clear to [REDACTED] that when the restraint chairs were delivered, they were to be inspected prior to signing the paperwork and releasing the FedEx driver. At some point during the process, Lt. Gabriel informed [REDACTED] that he was the owner of the policy and therefore needed to be involved. [REDACTED] informed Lt. Gabriel of the importance of the inspection prior to taking delivery. [REDACTED] also notified Warehouse Supervisor [REDACTED] regarding the delivery process that needed to occur and asked that they call him [REDACTED] when the chairs showed up. When the chairs showed up, [REDACTED] was notified. [REDACTED] notified Lt. Gabriel as he wished to be notified. [REDACTED] also requested Deputies [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to assist with the inspection of the chairs. [REDACTED] said they began inspecting the chairs and Lt. Gabriel showed up. As they were opening the packaging, they discovered 5 of the 6 chairs had damage on them. [REDACTED] asked where the FedEx driver was and Lt. Gabriel advised that he signed for the receipt of the chairs and the driver left. [REDACTED] was upset due to all of the damage on the chairs and the fact that Lt. Gabriel had signed for the chairs before being inspected. [REDACTED] left Lt. Gabriel with the warehouse staff. Lt. Gabriel called [REDACTED] and asked that he meet him in Pod 2 for the delivery of the chairs. Lt. Gabriel advised [REDACTED] that he notated the documents on the chairs you our (ACSO's) copy and then told the company that he did this when the driver was still there, and that the driver handed him back the paperwork with the notations on it. Lt. Gabriel told [REDACTED] to "just go with it" and it would be ok.

██████████ received an email from ██████████ at Safety Restraint Chair Inc, asking for help because FedEx is giving them pushback on this claim because the damages were written on the customer copy of the delivery receipt and not the driver copy. The email read, "When Crhis called me he said that the driver let him write the comments down on the customer copy and then handed it back to him before he left. FedEx is waiting for his side of the story before they will proceed. Can you assist with this?"

██████████ received an email from the claims rep from FedEx that partially read, "I guess what I am confused about is why they would sign the delivers copy as clear then sign the consignee's copy (which they keep) and say they signed it as damaged? Any clarification is appreciated!"

On 2/8/2022, ██████████ noticed chair parts in Lt. Gabriel's office and asked what was up with them. He advised that the chairs showed up damaged and he was working his way through it with the company. At this point ██████████ did not have all the information documented in this narrative so he did not inquire further. Lt. Gabriel said something about the driver's documents and a mix up.

On 2/9/2022, ██████████ called Warehouse Supervisor, ██████████ and he said that ██████████ made it clear to his staff that the chairs needed to be inspected prior to them signing for them. He was not sure if Lt. Gabriel or ██████████ signed for the chairs before they found the damages.

On 2/10/2022, ██████████ met with Lt. Gabriel at approximately 1335. He asked Lt. Gabriel what was going on with the restraint chairs. He said that he did a "bonehead Lt. thing." He told ██████████ that he signed for the receipt of the restraint chairs prior to them being inspected. ██████████ asked him if ██████████ made him aware of the fact that they needed to be inspected prior to signing for them and he said that he did originally. ██████████ then asked if at any time did he give ██████████ false information regarding the signing of the driver's receipt. Lt. Gabriel advised that he doesn't remember what he told her specifically, but he could have said he wrote the notes on the driver's copy and the driver gave it back to him.

On 2/11/2022, ██████████ called and spoke with ██████████ on the phone and she told him that when they ship their chairs, they put big red and white stickers on them that read, "Unwrap and Inspect prior to Accepting Delivery." ██████████ told him that FedEx was going to cover 1/3rd of the claim that she filed with them for the damages because the driver's copy wasn't filled out and signed. ██████████ told ██████████ that Lt. Gabriel told her that he made notes of the damages on the driver's copy while the driver was still there and then the driver handed him the copy back.

██████████ feels that Lt. Gabriel gave false information to ██████████ with Safety Restraint Chair Inc., which caused them to only be able to claim 1/3rd of their damages from FedEx. This cause the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office to look bad to two different outside entities.

Incident Summary

Notes: Alleged Complaint: On June 17, 2020 at about 2330, Deputy Ben Sadler, while on duty as an ACSO Patrol deputy, was completing a call for service when his precinct partner [REDACTED] noticed a folded piece of paper attached to the rear window of Deputy Sadler's patrol car. [REDACTED] was in training with Deputy Sadler and was also present. The deputies inspected the paper and discovered writing on the paper that stated "found you bitch" and included Deputy Sadler's previous home address. Also folded into the paper was one of Deputy Sadler's business cards with a drawing of "cross hairs." Deputy Sadler reported the incident to his supervisor, [REDACTED] and initiated ACSO case # AC20-9441. The note and business card were placed into ACSO evidence.

On June 18, 2020, ACSO Special Investigations Unit (SIU) was assigned to investigate the case. An extensive investigation was conducted. Based upon all of the established facts and evidence in the case, SIU investigators concluded that Deputy Sadler himself, likely placed the paper and business card on his own vehicle.

On August 6, 2020, Deputy Sadler agreed to participate in a voluntary follow-up interview with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. During the interview, Deputy Sadler confessed to authoring the note and placing the note and business card on his patrol vehicle.

Notes: Alleged Complaint: 10/23/19 [REDACTED] received a call from Dispatch [REDACTED] asking if he had license plate numbers on agency unmarked vehicles. She advised him that Aurora Police were out with a witness who was reporting a hit and run (auto/ped) involving a car that registers back to Arapahoe County. The plate number that was provided came back to unit 9885 assigned to Deputy Lara Dreiling. APD Agent [REDACTED] was requesting a phone call. At approximately 1321 hours, [REDACTED] contacted [REDACTED] who advised him that they (APD) were out with an RP who stated they witnessed a silver Ford Taurus strike a pedestrian at Arapahoe and Parker. The RP further stated that a female in full police uniform got out of the vehicle, spoke with the pedestrian then left the area. [REDACTED] stated the RP provided them with a photograph of the police vehicle. [REDACTED] requested to speak with the deputy. After speaking with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] advised Deputy Dreiling to call [REDACTED] Deputy Dreiling advised [REDACTED] at this point that she was not in that area and there were no incidents that happened with her or her vehicle. At approximately 1423 hours, [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] again to find out what his investigation came to. He advised that APD was taking an incident report (19-41389) since the only person they have been able to contact is the RP. [REDACTED] then requested dispatch to run the daily log for Deputy Dreiling (log is attached, however her AVL was showing disconnected and not able to show her actual locations). [REDACTED] requested Deputy Dreiling to come to headquarters to take photos of her vehicle. At approximately 1500 hours [REDACTED] began taking pictures where he noticed a small crease in the front of the hood. The hood had a thin layer of dust on it and there is no other damage to the front end. Deputy Dreiling advised [REDACTED] that the damage was a skateboarding accident involving her son a couple

weeks prior and wasn't reported.
