INCIDENT REPORT

NARRATIVE-

On 12/24/2021 at approximately 1912 hours, while on patrol in the Town of Parker, County of Douglas, State of Colorado, I was advised of a re-opened domestic violence at the address of [REDACTED]

All events within this report occurred in the Town of Parker unless otherwise noted.

I was advised by Officer Drew-Bell that the suspect from a previous call was possibly back at the residence, and there was probable cause for his arrest.

Upon my arrival, I was advised the male party in question, [REDACTED] was known to fight and/or run from law enforcement. I was advised to travel to the backside of the residence in case [REDACTED] fled out of the back entrance while other officers attempted contact at the front door.

When I arrived in position at the rear of the house, Officer Drew-Bell aired to me that I needed to come to the front of the house right away. I ran to the front of the house, and observed Officer Valko, and Officer Drew-Bell struggling with a male party in the front doorway. Officer Valko was ordering the male to let go of the door as he was under arrest. The male party refused to let go of the door, and refused to comply with commands. Officer Drew-Bell was able to free the male parties hand from the door, and I grabbed the male parties right wrist and arm. The male party was actively trying to pull away from Officer Valko and I, and was ordered to the ground. The male party complied and dropped to his knees, but would still not place his hands behind his back, was tucking his knees into his chest, and was thrashing his head forward and backwards. I grabbed the male parties head and held it to the floor so he would not injure himself or officers. I also again ordered the male party to stop resisting, and to place his hands behind his back. The male party refused to comply, however, officers had control of both of his hands and they were placed behind his back and he was handcuffed without further incident.

The male party was later identified as the suspect, [REDACTED]. While attempting to walk [REDACTED] out to the police vehicles, he refused to walk and was actively pushing his feet out in front of him to prevent us from walking with him. After Officers spoke to [REDACTED] about his charges and about sitting in the car without further resistance, [REDACTED] stated he [REDACTED] and was not cooperative with entering the vehicle. [REDACTED] was trying to push his right leg out of the vehicle, and was trying to unlatch the seatbelt which was he was buckled securely into. I advised [REDACTED] to stop, but due to his already violent nature, and [REDACTED], Officer Drew-Bell placed the Violent Prisoner restraint onto [REDACTED].

After [REDACTED] was securely placed in the vehicle, I remained on scene for a short while while victims paperwork was completed, and then cleared the area without further incident.

This report will serve as a summary of events only. During the incident, my body worn camera was activated, and may contain statements and/or details not reflected in this report.

NARRATIVE- VALKO, CHRIS 2113 2113

On December 23, 2021 at approximately 1658 hours I, Officer Valko with PTO Drew-Bell, were dispatched to the Parker Police Station on a Domestic Violence Call that had occurred on December 21, 2021 at [REDACTED] in the Town of Parker, County of Douglas, State of Colorado.

I was advised by call notes and Parker Dispatch that [REDACTED] was in the lobby of the Parker Police Station. [REDACTED] had a photo concerning [REDACTED] being abused by her boyfriend, [REDACTED] was concerned about an ongoing pattern of abuse. [REDACTED] had audio of [REDACTED] hitting [REDACTED] and had a picture of [REDACTED] black eye. [REDACTED] noted that [REDACTED] had a history of being aggressive with police and had held [REDACTED] captive prior to this event and [REDACTED] was charged with kidnapping.

Upon arrival I contacted [REDACTED]. I conducted a recorded interview in a police interview room. [REDACTED] expressed to me his concern over [REDACTED] wellbeing. [REDACTED] stated that he was [REDACTED], but had received three audio files from [REDACTED] and the files were recorded by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] also had a photo of injuries to [REDACTED] left eye. The photo was taken by [REDACTED] who is [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

I listened to the three audio recordings. [REDACTED] confirmed that the female voice on the recording was [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] was somewhat certain that the male voice belonged to [REDACTED] positively identified [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] from photos he had on his phone. I had dossier photos pulled for both [REDACTED]. The photos that [REDACTED] had were the same people listed on the dossier photos.

[REDACTED] discussed [REDACTED] black eye with [REDACTED] prior to his interview with me. [REDACTED] told me that [REDACTED] was also concerned about [REDACTED] but worried that police involvement might escalate the violence between [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had been in a relationship for approximately 4 years. Prior to [REDACTED] turning 18 years old, [REDACTED] had a Protection Order issued listing [REDACTED] as the protected party and [REDACTED] as the restrained party. [REDACTED] told me that he knew of at least two incidents when [REDACTED] was arrested on domestic violence charges. [REDACTED] knew that [REDACTED] allowed [REDACTED] to driver her car, because [REDACTED] did not have a car of his own. [REDACTED] told me that he feared that [REDACTED] was capable of escalating his abuse of [REDACTED] to the point of killing her.

[REDACTED] told me that he believed that [REDACTED] was driving [REDACTED] car and [REDACTED] was trying to get to work on December 21, 2021. [REDACTED] told me that [REDACTED] was supposed to arrive at her place of business, which is [REDACTED] in Parker, at approximately 1300 hours but was unsure if she made it to work. [REDACTED] believed that [REDACTED] would likely not be truthful about how she sustained the black eye. [REDACTED] told me that he knew that [REDACTED] lived in apartments near [REDACTED]. I found that [REDACTED] had the address of [REDACTED] listed on his driver's license, which was a consistent location that [REDACTED] had provided.

I contacted [REDACTED] by phone. [REDACTED] told me that she was also concerned about [REDACTED] safety. [REDACTED] played the audio files that [REDACTED] had for [REDACTED] provided [REDACTED] with the audio and allowed [REDACTED] to take a photo of her injuries. [REDACTED] was told by [REDACTED] that her black eye was the result of [REDACTED] "accidentally" striking her face. [REDACTED] agreed to meet with me and see if [REDACTED] would provide a statement. [REDACTED] believed that [REDACTED] was looking for a way out of the relationship.

I contacted [REDACTED] at her residence, where [REDACTED] was staying. I spoke with [REDACTED] who told me that on December 21, 2021 she had been in her car with [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] and she got into her car at [REDACTED] address. [REDACTED] was driving and they were in an argument. [REDACTED] told me that when they arrived in [REDACTED] neighborhood, [REDACTED] continued driving around and would not let [REDACTED] out of the car. [REDACTED] asked several times to be let out and for [REDACTED] to stop the car. [REDACTED] told me that she started honking the horn to try to get [REDACTED] to stop. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was trying to push her hands away from the steering wheel and "accidentally" struck her in the left eye, causing the injuries observed in the photo provided by [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if she felt that [REDACTED] did not let her out of the car because he was trying to control her. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had brought her personal items to her place of business and both agreed to end the relationship. [REDACTED] did not want to pursue charges regarding this incident.

I noted that [REDACTED] appeared to be guarded in her responses to my questions and kept her responses brief. [REDACTED] did not want to go into detail about the incident. [REDACTED] told me that she was "accidentally" struck in the left eye, and that this was not the first time [REDACTED] had "accidentally" injured her. [REDACTED] noted previous incidents where [REDACTED]

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"accidentally" caused bruising on her arms from grabbing her.

I later checked for calls for service that might have related to this incident. I learned that Parker Police were dispatched to [redacted] address on December 21, 2021 for a disturbance and [redacted] was contacted. I spoke with Officer [redacted] who completed an information report on the incident (see CR [redacted]). Officer [redacted] told me that when [redacted] left, [redacted] stated that he had to go pick up his girlfriend. [redacted] was advised of an active protection order, and [redacted] stated that the protection order had been modified.

I confirmed that there was an active protection order and an expired protection order. The stipulations for the active protection order ([redacted]) indicated that [redacted] was the restrained party, [redacted] was the protected party. The stipulations prohibited [redacted] from "assaulting, threatening, abusing, harassing, following, interfering, or stalking," and is restrained, [redacted], from making any communication that "would be likely to cause annoyance or alarm to," [redacted] only was allowed to communicate with [redacted] electronically or in a public place.

I further reviewed the audio files that [redacted] had uploaded to evidence.com. During the recordings [redacted] asked several times to be taken to [redacted] house because she needed to go to work. [redacted] replied to [redacted], "Sorry, sorry no." [redacted] repeatedly screamed things like "SHUT THE FUCK UP," "YOU STUPID BITCH." WILLIAM acknowledged that [redacted] was begging him not to be hit prior to the recording. [redacted], "You punched me dead ass in my jaw." [redacted] asked [redacted], "Why are you just driving around my neighborhood?"

[redacted] told [redacted], "Just listen to me and don't yell at me and you'll make it to work." [redacted] told [redacted] that she hated him and [redacted] responded, "Saying that shit, you're not going to make it."

I requested criminal histories for [redacted] and [redacted] did not have any criminal history.

[redacted] had an extensive criminal history to include arrests for assault kidnapping and violation of a court order.

I attempted to contact [redacted] at his apartment, but it appeared that no one was home. I contacted [redacted] mother who also resides in the apartment and was told that [redacted] did not have a phone, but she would pass along my information for [redacted] to contact me. As of December 24, 2021 at 0340 hours, [redacted] had not called me back.

At approximately 1746 hours on December 24, 2021 an attempt to locate for [redacted] was entered into CCIC on December 24, 2021 requesting that he be detained and held for Parker Police to arrest.

On December 24, 2021 at approximately 1912 hours, I attempted to contact [redacted] at his residence at [redacted] [redacted] in the Town of Parker, County of Douglas, State of Colorado. [redacted] answered the door. I was in full Parker Police uniform. When [redacted] saw me he began shutting the door. I grabbed [redacted] shirt as he tried to retreat back into his apartment. [redacted] told me that his name was not [redacted]. I along with two other officers were able to use empty hand controls to subdue [redacted] and place him into custody. [redacted] was escorted to my patrol car in handcuffs, and remained uncooperative. [redacted] was reluctant to get into the patrol car and made a statement that he was going to [redacted]. I deployed the VP-200 and secured [redacted] to prevent him from [redacted] during transport.

Once [redacted] was in custody, I learned that [redacted] was located in [redacted] bedroom, in violation of their no contact provision in the previously mentioned restraining order. I completed the Lethality Assessment Questionnaire with [redacted]. Based on the audio that I previously listened to it did not seem that [redacted] was again withholding information. [redacted] refused contact from a Victim's Assistant, but was provided VINE and VRA information.

[redacted] was transported to the Douglas County Jail without incident. Once at the jail [redacted] made statements to suggest that he had video of the December 21, 2021 incident. [redacted] was informed that he could provide that video to me at a later time or to his legal counsel. [redacted] was advised to retain the video. [redacted] also stated that he was assaulted by [redacted]. I photographed visible marks and injuries on [redacted] told me that none of the marks on his neck, arms, head, or hands were from the arrest and that they were previous injuries and suggested that they were defensive injuries. [redacted] declined to provide a statement.
