AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF WARRANTLESS ARREST

The affiant, Colton Tennyson, a commissioned police officer with the City of Westminster being duly sworn upon oath, says that there is probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named defendant for the charge(s) stated above. The affiant affirms that the following facts are true and correct to the best of his/her knowledge, information, and belief, and that those facts support the arrest of the defendant. The affiant (hereafter referred to as "I" or "me") informs the court of the following:

Colton Tennyson #21-11, a police officer with the City of Westminster, being duly sworn upon oath says that there is probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the defendant, Matthew Oliver for the charge(s) 18-4-203(1) and 18-4-401(1)(2)(E) , arising out of incidents occurring at 860 W 132ND Ave lot #308 in the City of Westminster, Adams County, Colorado on January 2nd, 2022 and the following facts are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief and support the arrest of the defendant:

On January 1st, 2022 at 0852 hours, your affiant was dispatched to 860 W 132ND Ave #308 located in the City of Westminster, Adams County, and State of Colorado reference to a burglary report. On scene your affiant met with (V) Dino Chatham DOB 10/01/1963.

According to Dino, he was away from his residence since 12/31/2021 to stay at a friend's house to watch over their animals. Dino returned back to his residence on 1/2/2022 to discover his front door damaged and opened up. Dino said his living room was in disarray and according to Dino he recalled leaving the residence in a clean manner. Dino told me he was missing a pool stick, 2 black statues, a chess set, and missing a book. The value of the property missing totaled \$400.00 dollars.

Dino told me, he believes he knows who did this and proceeded to showing me text messages from his neighbor (OF) Matthew Oliver DOB 01/20/1980 who resides at lot #308. Matthew stated from a screenshotted text message, "I know you're busy and so I'll grab my things from your house bro you don't have to worry about getting back in touch with me". The text messages were dated on 1/1/2022 at 0237 hours from Matthew.

Dino told me that no one had permission inside of his residence and all property listed above belonged to him.

I later returned for follow up on 1/2/2022 at 1342 hours. Dino told me that he discovered more property missing to include 2 black watches. The watches were valued by Dino to total \$700.00. Dino provided me Matthews phone number. Matthew agreed to speak to me in person.

Matthew admitted to entering inside of Dino's property on 1/1/2021 around 0200-0300 hours, consistent with the timeframe of the screenshots provided by Dino. Matthew while on a walk said he noticed the front door of Dino's residence was opened up. Matthew said he entered inside of the residence and proceeded to gather items that he said belonged to him. The items Matthew described to me were a book and chess set. Matthew told me prior to my arrival he returned a pool stick to Dino. The items listed from Matthew were indeed the one's mentioned from Dino leading me to believe there is probable cause for the offense of Second-Degree Burglary as defined by C.R.S. 18-4-203, Theft as defined by 18-4-401(1)(2)(B).


The affiant informs the court that Matthew Oliver DOB 01-20-1980, White Male, 5'10", 135lbs, Brown Hair, Hazel eyes, State ID# [REDACTED] and FBI# [REDACTED]
