On 8/23/2025 at approximately 0145 hours, [REDACTED] called CSPD Communications Center to report that her neighbor was kicking at her apartment door and was trying to break down her door. [REDACTED] reported that only one hinge was left on her door because the suspect had damaged the other two. [REDACTED] had made numerous 911 calls on 8/22/2025 and 8/23/2025 regarding similar incidents. [REDACTED] and David Green arrived on scene and found no signs of a disturbance occurring and no damage to her door or the hinges. Officers observed that [REDACTED] was displaying signs of intoxication from alcohol.

Due to the number of calls placed by [REDACTED] that were unfounded, Officers handcuffed, frisked, and detained [REDACTED] in a patrol car while a summons for False Information was completed. [REDACTED] was served and released with a summons. After being released, [REDACTED] called 911 and reported that the officers had touched her inappropriately.

[REDACTED] reported that she was handcuffed, frisked, and given a criminal citation for False Information. [REDACTED] said when she was frisked, the officer "touched her all over". [REDACTED] would not explain what that meant, only that she was wearing a robe and it was not necessary for the officer to frisk her. [REDACTED] also claimed the officers did not have probable cause to arrest her.

I reviewed BWC for this incident and did not observe any inappropriate behavior by the officers. Officer D. Green conducted the frisk.

1/2/26: this case was closed by PI on 9/9/25, but on 12/31/25, complainant re-contacted investigating supervisor, [REDACTED], via 9 missed calls. She then called for a CFS for harassment; from the CFS she reported [REDACTED] was calling her repeatedly, no mention that it was a police supervisor, so the CFS was assigned to DRL. Per the CFS, once DLR officer realized she wasn't reporting a criminal complaint, she was referred to a supervisor for making a complaint. See attached email from [REDACTED]. The complaint that an officer inappropriately touched her was already handled by this PI and will not be re-opened. At this time, IA has no information

that she has reached out to a supervisor to make a complaint against an officer, though the DLR officer did provide her info on how to do so. --avl/3526

06/08/2026: [REDACTED] left a message for IA regarding her same complaint against [REDACTED]. She claims that [REDACTED] is a liar and a manipulator and he should not have a gun and badge. She did not say anything about filing a complaint, and there were no new complaints stated. Voicemail is attached.
