This event was recorded using the mounted, in-car camera and wireless, body-worn microphone installed in car CSP367. The recordings are stored on the digital evidence server located at the CSP Troop Office in Fort Collins.

This narrative is a summary of events as they occurred and is not intended to be an exact transcription.

This event occurred solely within the county of Larimer, state of Colorado unless otherwise reported.

PHASE I - Vehicle in Motion:

On 07/09/2022, I, Trooper J. Sugai, was dressed in my regular duty uniform parked in the median of Interstate 25 facing northbound with my parking lights on. I observed a dark-colored pickup northbound on Interstate 25 at milepost 261, traveling at a high rate of speed in the left lane. I estimated the vehicle's speed to be 90 MPH as it passed me. With good audio and visual confirmation of the vehicle's speed, I locked the vehicle's speed with my front radar unit, traveling away from me at 92 MPH in a clearly posted 65 MPH zone. There also was active construction this night.

I caught up to the vehicle at approximately milepost 263 on Interstate 25. As I followed the vehicle, which was later identified as a black 2017 Ford F-150 with Colorado Registration of CFFD19, I observed the vehicle weave over the left shoulder line, the right shoulder line and cross over the center dashed line several times (See below attached photos from dash camera). I followed the pickup and its speed continued to be in the range of 90 to 100 MPH. As the pickup approached E. Harmony Road, I activated my lights and the vehicle did not exit and was slow to react to my lights. The vehicle had to move from the left lane to the right lane due to construction closing the left lane. The vehicle continued at a high rate of speed and finally appeared to react to my emergency lights. The vehicle exited at the off ramp to the Colorado State Patrol Fort Collins office. The vehicle came to a stop at the entrance gate to the office.

PHASE II - Personal Contact:

I contacted the driver, who was later identified as Jacob Ronald HODGE, DOB 10/09/1996. I introduced myself to HODGE and he answered and spoke very abruptly and short. I immediately smelled a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from HODGE's breath when he spoke. I advised HODGE I was contacting him for his speed and weaving and he had no answer when I asked his reason. HODGE stated he was traveling from Thornton, CO to Fort Collins, CO to meet up with a friend. I asked HODGE for his information and he asked if he could get his information from the glove box. I advised HODGE he could get his information and he advised me he had a Glock firearm in the glove box, which I did not observe when he opened it. HODGE tapped on the center console and stated he had the Glock in the glove box. I confirmed with HODGE that the firearm was in the center console and not in the glove box, which HODGE confirmed.

HODGE fumbled with the paperwork for the vehicle and handed me the registration and his driver's license. I advised HODGE I could smell a strong odor of alcohol coming from his breath. HODGE told me he had "one beer with dinner" at approximately 1900 hours and at the current time, it was approximately 0200 the following morning. I advised HODGE it did not smell like he had only one beer due to the strength of odor coming from his breath. HODGE told me again, he only had one beer with dinner. I asked HODGE what he thought his level of intoxication was on a scale of zero to ten. HODGE told me he thought his intoxication level was a "two". During my interaction with HODGE, I observed his eyes to be bloodshot and watery with his pupils appearing to be dilated. HODGE's speech appeared to be slurred at times during my conversation with him.

Trooper W. Bradley and Trooper J. Curtis arrived on scene during my interaction with HODGE. I queried HODGE through Denver Regional Communication Center (DRCC) and asked HODGE if he would be willing to perform voluntary roadside tests to make sure he was safe to drive. HODGE agreed to the voluntary tests and stepped out of his vehicle. As HODGE walked to the rear of his vehicle, he appeared unsteady and brushed against the side of his truck.

PHASE III - Pre-Arrest Screening:

➤ Medical Screening Interview:

I asked HODGE preliminary questions to make sure he was capable of performing the voluntary tests. Due to HODGE's answers to my questions, I deemed him capable to perform the tests.

➤ Preliminary Breath Screening (PBT):

This portion of voluntary roadides was administered last. HODGE's submitted a breath sample and the PBT detected alcohol and reported the result of .145.

HODGE agreed to participate with the voluntary field sobriety tests, which they did not perform satisfactorily according to my training and experience. For details on HODGE's overall performance refer to CSP Form 203 (Impairment Examination Report) that is included with this report.

During the voluntary tests, HODGE advised me he was a law enforcement officer with Longmont Police Department. HODGE advised he was two weeks into his field training program and stated he knew the tests that he was performing. When I instructed HODGE on the Walk and Turn test, HODGE stated he was trained to take ten steps when I advised him to take nine steps. I advised HODGE to take nine steps as it is trained in the Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) manual.

ARREST:

At 0215 hours, HODGE was arrested for the suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or a combination of alcohol and drugs. HODGE was placed into a "transport belt" and fit into double-locked handcuffs without incident or any use of force. This was done in accordance with departmental policies and training guidelines. HODGE was searched incident to arrest and then secured in the backseat of my patrol car. HODGE was not seat belted in due to proximity to the Colorado State Patrol office.

Trooper J. Curtis and Trooper W. Bradley assisted in searching HODGE's vehicle and Trooper J. Curtis retrieved the firearm from the center console of the vehicle.

EXPRESSED CONSENT AND CHEMICAL TESTING:

I transported HODGE to the Colorado State Patrol Fort Collins office to administer the evidential breath alcohol test (EBAT). Upon arrival I visually inspected HODGE's mouth for any piercings, removable dental devices, or foreign objects that may interfere with the successful completion of the EBAT. Once satisfied HODGE's mouth was clear, I advised HODGE not to burp, belch, regurgitate, or otherwise bring any contents up from their stomach and into their mouth. I asked if he understood my instructions and HODGE replied he understood. At 0229 hours the 20-minute deprivation period began and ended at 0242 hours due to HODGE belching. The 20-minute deprivation period was restarted at 0245 hours and was completed without incident.

At 0311 hours, HODGE submitted fully cooperated with the completion of their chosen chemical test. The results of HODGE EBAT was .157 grams of ethyl alcohol per 210 liters of breath. This EBAT was successfully completed, without exception and within two hours of HODGE operating a motor vehicle within the state of Colorado.

This chemical breath test was completed using an Intoxilyzer I9000 EBAT Instrument, which I am currently certified as an operator. The serial number for the I9000 instrument is 90-000382, which is currently certified by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE). (See included certificates)

During the time at the Colorado State Patrol office waiting for the EBAT to be conducted, HODGE kept asking repetitive questions about what was going to happen to him, what I thought was going to happen, the process of everything. I answered HODGE's questions and he kept asking the same questions.


HODGE was released to a sober person, Lauren Hawes from the office. A copy of Uniform Summons & Complaint Form (CSP4) 6305048 was issued to him with the following charges:

1. C.R.S. §42-4-1301(1)(a) HODGE drove a motor vehicle, or vehicle under the influence of alcohol or one or more drugs, or a combination of alcohol or one or more drugs and that voluntary consumption affected HODGE to a degree that they were substantially incapable, either mentally or physically, or both mentally and physically, to exercise clear judgement, sufficient physical control, or due care in the safe operation of a vehicle.
2. C.R.S. §42-4-1301(2)(a) HODGE drove a motor vehicle upon the streets and highways and elsewhere throughout this state with an alcohol concentration of .080 or greater within two hours of operating a motor vehicle. The results of which would be confirmed by a certified chemical test that HODGE cooperated in the taking and completion of as required.
3. C.R.S. §42-4-1101(1) HODGE was speeding 92 MPH in a 65 MPH construction zone. HODGE was speeding 25-39 MPH over the posted speed limit in a construction zone.
4. C.R.S. §42-4-1007(1)(a) HODGE failed to drive as nearly as practicable entirely within a single lane.
5. C.R.S. §18-12-106(1)(d) HODGE possessed a weapon while under the influence of an intoxicating liquor or a controlled substance.

All property found on HODGE when searched incident to arrest was released to him.

HODGE's vehicle was locked and secured on the shoulder in front of the Colorado State Patrol office entrance. HODGE provided written roadside authorization to do so.
