Please note: Juveniles are not allowed to pay fines; a court appearance is required with a parent or legal guardian.

YOUR RIGHTS AS A DEFENDANT FOR CRIMINAL CHARGES (DRMC and CRS)

As a defendant, you are guaranteed the privilege of exercising certain inherent rights IN COURT, as listed below:

1. The right to appear before a judge or magistrate, and be advised of the charge(s) and the maximum possible penalty and costs that may result in the event of conviction;
2. The right to enter a not guilty plea, and to have a trial by a judge, a magistrate, or a jury;
3. The right to be represented by an attorney at your own expense; and if you are indigent, to request appointment of an attorney (which may be granted or denied);
4. The right to appear in person and request a reasonable continuance to hire an attorney, to determine the plea you wish to enter, or for other good and sufficient reason;
5. The right to present witnesses on your behalf, and the right to have subpoenas issued by the Court at no cost, in order to compel the attendance of witnesses on your behalf; however the cost of serving subpoenas on witnesses is your expense;
6. The right to cross-examine prosecution witnesses at trial. The right to testify, or not to testify on your own behalf at trial, with the understanding that you have the right to remain silent, and that any statement made by you at any time can and may be used against you;
7. The right to appear in person before a judge or magistrate, and make an explanation to the Court if you enter a plea of guilty, or nolo contendere;
8. The right to a jury trial;
9. The right to post bail if your offense is bailable, and the right to be informed of the amount of bail that has been set by the Court;
10. The right to appeal your case to the Denver District Court upon conviction at trial.

DENVER REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE (DRMC) Payable Non-Criminal Violations ("IF" Designation)

You may pay a non-criminal infraction prior to the court date and by doing so, you are taking advantage of the offer by the City Attorney to pay a \$100 fine + costs regardless of how many prior offenses you have. If you choose not to pay before the court date, you are required to appear in court at the date and time shown on your summons and complaint. If you are found liable in court, or if you fail to appear and a default judgment enters against you, you will be assessed a fine up to \$150 for a first offense, a fine up to \$500 for a second offense, and a fine up to \$999 for any subsequent offense. To contest the charge(s), you must appear at the date and time shown on your summons and complaint and enter a not-labile plea; at which time a final hearing will be scheduled for a future date. If you are found liable at the final hearing, fines, fees and costs will be assessed. Additional costs for collections may also be assessed if you do not pay your fines and costs. To pay before court, go to: www.denvercountycourt.org You may also pay before your court date by mail with a check or money order; or in person with cash, credit card, check or money order. If you are paying by mail or in person, this signed form must accompany your payment.

YOUR RIGHTS AS A DEFENDANT FOR NON-CRIMINAL INFRACTIONS

1. The right to appear before a magistrate;
2. The right to enter a not-labile plea, and have a final hearing by a judge or magistrate;
3. The right to hire an attorney at your own expense;
4. The right to remain silent because any statement made by you can be used against you;
5. The right to testify or not testify, subpoena witnesses, present evidence and cross-examine witnesses for the City;
6. The right to appeal.
