### Incident Summary

090120- The complainant left a message with Internal Affairs. I spoke with the complainant, who felt Officer Jeffrey Johnson-Dean (6806) and ██████ harassed him at the Antler's Hotel on August 31, 2020.

The complainant's account of the incident was a little disjointed. He first said the officers called him over the phone to notify him out his ex-wife's murder for the Denver Police. He said the officers were "excessive rude", harassing and unsympathetic about the situation. When I questioned him why the officers would be calling for the Denver Police when he lived in Denver, the complainant then said the officers came to his hotel room and harassed him and his son. -CCI Theresa Person (6330)

092120, I watched the BWC footage of the incident. Officer Johnson-Dean and ██████ responded to the Antlers Hotel regarding a disturbance. Officer Johnson-Dean and ██████ accompanied by hotel staff went to the room occupied by the complainant, his son, girlfriend and their son. Officer Johnson-Dean knocked several times of the door before the complainant told the officers to go away and they weren't coming in without a warrant. Officer Johnson-Dean said the hotel was working on evicting the complainant. The complainant asked if the officers had their guns out and said "Hands up. Don't shoot." Officer Johnson-Dean said he was a black police officer and didn't appreciate the comment. The complainant asked what the officers needed. ██████ said they needed to make sure everyone was okay. The complainant opened the door and told the officers they could come and see he was murdering everyone. Officer Johnson-Dean told the complainant to lose the attitude. The complainant told Officer Johnson-Dean "so can you. Bye." and slammed the door shut.

Officer Johnson-Dean knocked again. The complainant's girlfriend came out and talked with Officer Johnson-Dean and ██████ about what had transpired. ██████ explained the reason the officers were there and said they just needed to check and make sure everyone was okay. The girlfriend said everyone was and asked if she could have the boys step into the hall instead of the officers going in the room to prevent issues. The officers said they just needed to check on everyone. The girlfriend had the boys step out of the room. The officers talked to them. The girlfriend, who appeared stressed, assured the officers that the complainant had never been physical with her or the boys and that his ex-wife was murdered and he was angry with the world. The boys went back in the room. The girlfriend remained in the hall and began crying. She again assured the officers the complainant had never been physical. The officers said abuse could take many forms. The girlfriend said she understood but things would be okay. The officers left.

After his initial complaint, the complainant called back (9/8/20) claiming he was harassed again and gave the officers' numbers. Those numbers were not number belonging to members of the Colorado Springs Police Department. I contacted the complainant and advised him that it appeared those officers were with another agency- CCI Theresa Person (6330)
