Summary:

On 08/25/2025, I, Lt. D. Jeltres/3816 was conducting use of force reviews on two separate calls for service. Upon reviewing these uses of force, I observed actions taken and not taken by Ofc. J. Johnson-Dean/6806 that were questionable. These questionable decisions continue to show a concerning pattern of behavior by Ofc. Johnson-Dean regarding his decision making on calls for service and attention to detail.

Call for service [REDACTED]:

- Failed to provide Miranda to a suspect prior to questioning despite suspect having a gun pointed at him, force was used against him and handcuffed in the back of a police car. Also, failed to properly investigate the call for service only asking questions surrounding DUI and ignoring the assault on a peace officer, despite direction to do so from a supervisor.
- When asked by the suspect about getting a phone call provided information contrary to CSPD policy and Colorado law.
- Did not allow the suspect to use a bathroom when requested while one was nearby and available.

Call for service [REDACTED]:

- Completed a BlueTeam report for use of force but failed to complete a supplement to the offense report. When asked he stated he forgot to do it.

These concerns were discussed with Cmdr. B. Cummings/2301 and the decision was made to initiate a Level 2 investigation.
