Summary:

On 02/27/2023 at approximately 0115 hours I, Lt. R. Tepley/3525, was working the duty desk at the Sand Creek Substation when I received a phone call from the Colorado Springs Police Department's Communications Center in reference to an individual named [REDACTED] calling in to make a complaint regarding an interaction he had with officers.

I contacted [REDACTED] at phone number [REDACTED] and he provided the following information. [REDACTED] stated that he was at the 7-11 near Pikes Peak and Academy Boulevard to buy food off of the grill for his children. He noticed that some of the grill rollers were not functioning properly so he asked the employee if the items on the grill were cooked and ready to be eaten. He mentioned that the employee was rude and said that all the items were ready and he pointed out to her that some of the rollers were not working and he did not want to feed his children raw or uncooked chicken. He stated that the female employee then told him to "get the fuck out" of the store. She also told him she was going to call the police. [REDACTED] told her to go ahead and call the police and he waited on scene for the police to arrive.

When officers arrived he said that one of the officers was very rude to him and took his ID and then told him he didn't need to talk to him and that he went straight to the employee to get her statement. [REDACTED] said that he was not arrested for trespassing but that one of the officers was rude during the interaction. [REDACTED] said that he got "lippy" with that officer and as the officers were leaving one of the officers told him "I'll see you soon" after having already seen his identification with his address on it. [REDACTED] perceived this to be a direct threat to his safety. [REDACTED] stated he called his attorney and she agreed with him that this was a threat against his safety by the involved officers. [REDACTED] stated his attorney is Cindy Hyatt with Hyatt Law at phone number 719-659-7233. [REDACTED] stated that he recorded the entire interaction with the involved officers and that he wanted to file an official complaint for being threatened by officers on scene.

I recorded the phone call via the voice memo app on my department cell phone but am not able to send it to my email to attach it to this Blue Team.

On 03/05/2023, this incident was sent to me [Sgt. James Thurman 5101] by Lt Tepley via BlueTeam. I compiled additional information for this complaint and have attached it to the investigation. I saw that both involved officers have BWC for this incident and have marked it as complaint for retention purposes. The BWC footage has been shared with the Sand Creek Chain of command. The investigation will be sent back to the Sand Creek Chain of command for investigation.
