Summary:

On 9/25/20224 I, Lt. R. Tepley/3525, was working at the duty desk of the Sand Creek Patrol Division. I was informed that [REDACTED] was calling to inquire about a traffic accident that her daughter was involved in on 9/21/2024. [REDACTED] wanted to know why a traffic accident

report was not taken when the officer arrived on scene.

████████ informed me that her daughter was stopped in traffic on South Academy Blvd at Astrozon Blvd when she was rear ended. ██████ said that her daughter informed her that she was rear ended and that a male got out of the driver seat of the other vehicle. The male smelled of alcohol and was unsteady on his feet. There was a female passenger in the car as well. The officer arrived on scene and spoke to the female passenger of the other vehicle and that female said that she was the one driving the vehicle. ██████ daughter told her that she told the officer that it was the male that was driving and that he tried to drive away from the accident scene until her daughter stepped in front of the vehicle to keep him from leaving. When the driver exited the vehicle he smelled of alcohol and appeared to be drunk. ██████ said that her daughter told her that the officer was dismissive of this information and said that they could cold report the accident online.

████████ concern was that she tried to cold report the accident online but it would not allow her to do that because there was alcohol involved in the accident and the damage was more than \$1,000. ██████ said that her vehicle sustained heavy damage to the rear part of the vehicle and that the airbags deployed. ██████ informed me that her daughter is 22 years old and had never had something like this happen before so she just did what the officer said. ██████ concern was that, according to her daughter, the officer did not investigate who was actually driving the other vehicle and did not check for signs of impairment on the other driver. ██████ was also concerned because she needed a traffic accident report taken so that she could provide that information to her insurance provider.

I contacted a traffic officer and requested that officer to contact ██████ and start the process over and complete a traffic accident report if necessary. ██████ did not want to file a complaint, however, based on my review of the call for service and the circumstances of this incident I am opening a Level 1 investigation on the involved officer who did not complete a traffic accident report on the night of the incident.

No external notifications necessary as this complaint was supervisor initiated. (Sgt. Duncan)
