Summary:

On 6/14/23 a citizen contacted the Colorado Springs Police Department Internal Affairs Unit to file a complaint. The complainant was identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: 9/29/76). The complainant stated that he was involved in a disturbance that stemmed from a noise complaint on 6/12/23. The complainant stated that he called to report the noise complaint against a business located near his residence that was playing loud music. The complainant confronted the business owner about this issue and was assaulted. The officer that responded and communicated with the complainant seemed to side with the business owner and was not being impartial. The officer would not allow the complainant to press charges for assault. The complainant stated that the officer would not give the complainant his name, badge number, a case number, or a call screen number. The complainant feels that the officer did not care about what was happening to the complainant and instead of properly addressing the situation, just told the complainant to go home.
