Summary:

On 6/19/23 a citizen contacted the Colorado Springs Police Department Internal Affairs Unit by email to file a complaint. The complainant was identified as [REDACTED]. The complainant states that on 7/22/22 her son, identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: 03/19/87), was arrested for DUID. The complainant stated that her son was sleeping in his car when he was contacted by police. The complainant stated that the car didn't run, and he was sleeping inside of it to keep it from being towed away. The complainant's son was removed from the car by Colorado Springs Police Officers, handcuffed, and arrested for DUID. The complainant stated that officers used "glassy eyes" as justification for the DUID charge and she felt that was not right. The complainant felt that her son was never offered a breathalyzer test, and he passed a field sobriety test. The complainant's son was then told that he was being taken for a blood test. Ultimately the complainant's son did not submit to a blood test and the complainant feels that her son was not given a chance to explain why. The complainant's son was then charged, plead guilty while not fully understanding what he was doing, and has been sentenced to probation where he now has to call in every morning to his probation officer. The complainant feels that this has ruined her son's future. The Officer that arrested the complainant's son and charged him with DUID was identified as Officer Johnson-Dean #6806. The complainant referenced El Paso County Court case number [REDACTED]
