Summary:

Complainant, [REDACTED], sent a handwritten complaint to Internal Affairs via US mail. He alleges that on 08/25/2020, Ofc. Jeffrey Johnson-Dean arrested him and took him to OC. [REDACTED] said he had a dog bite on his leg and the nurse at OC refused to book him without a medical clearance. He then said that Ofc. Johnson-Dean took him to Memorial Hospital where he was implanted with a tracking device in his leg. [REDACTED] says that "they" have been torturing him using that tracker ever since.

In another instance, unknown date/time, [REDACTED] said that either CSPD or a deputy commander from the jail had an ambulance take him to Memorial Hospital where he was held down and injected with a yellow substance. He said that after this ear buds were placed in his ears. He said he was then released on the street where he was almost ran over by vehicles 3-4 times.

I, Internal Affairs Sgt. James Thurman reviewed BWC for this incident and located no footage to substantiate [REDACTED] claims. [REDACTED] arrest paperwork documented that he presented as EDP.

I would recommend this complaint be closed after preliminary inquiry-no policy violation as it is not based in reality and there is no evidence to support [REDACTED] allegations.

On 3/5/2025, [REDACTED] left a voicemail for Internal Affairs wanting to speak to IA Lt. Stankey. As the complaint is under investigation with the Division, and the letter complainant received refers the complainant to the Division for questions, then no further action was

taken by IA. Complainant appears to be EDP. Voicemail attached.

On 4/4/25 the Internal Affairs Unit received a written letter from [REDACTED] regarding this same complaint. On 4/7/25 I, CCI Strachan 1778, added the letter to this complaint. The letter did not contain a new complaint or new information. [REDACTED] complaint is not based in reality and [REDACTED] is EDP.
