Summary:

On 3/3/2020, complainant contacted Internal Affairs regarding filing a complaint from a CFS that occurred back in July, 2019. Complainant alleged SO punched her in the back and screamed at her. Complainant said after she was placed in handcuffs she had a purse around her shoulder/ chest area. When SO was trying to pull it off it caused her pants and part of her panties to come down. Complainant said the officer's actions caused her to have triggers from PTSD. Complainant said she filed a complaint with the responding sergeant in December and was checking on the status of that complaint. I informed complainant we did not have any record of a previous complaint and she advised she wanted to file one today.
