Summary:

On 11/28/23 the Colorado Springs Police Department Internal Affairs Unit received an envelope from a complainant identified as [REDACTED]. The envelope was dropped off at the front desk at the POC addressed to Internal Affairs Unit. The envelope contained a packet consisting of 37 printed pages of photos, and information and a thumb drive. The complainant felt the information in the packet and thumb drive contained evidence that Detective J. Granillo #3876, knowingly and repeatedly made untruthful statements concerning material facts, and knowingly omitted material facts, regarding his investigation associated with CSPD case report number [REDACTED].

This case report documented a First Degree assault investigation that culminated in the arrest of [REDACTED] (DOB: 06/17/02) on multiple charges of First Degree Murder (Attempted), First Degree Assault, and Reckless endangerment.

This complaint included the execution of a search warrant at the complainant's address of [REDACTED] on 3/23/23. Several Officers with TEU assisted detectives with taking the suspect into custody and executing the search warrant. The complainant feels that the following TEU officers unnecessarily damaged several security cameras and a computer. [REDACTED]

The complainant stated that [REDACTED] also attempted to interfere with the complainant's wife trying to record their interaction with police. While the complainant was viewing BWC footage made available to them, they noted that [REDACTED] also intentionally covered his BWC lens with black tape making it impossible to view his BWC.

This complaint was divided into two separate investigations. This complaint includes the complaint against Detective Granillo. The complaint against TEU officers was routed to the Specialized Enforcement Division for investigation.

On 02-28-24, Internal Affairs received a letter from [REDACTED]. The letter was [REDACTED] replying to the findings letters that were sent to him at the conclusion of this and other internal Affairs complaints. [REDACTED] was indicating that he was not pleased with the outcomes and wanted to complain on the chain of command that had come to the conclusions. After a discussion with Commander Frabbiele, it was decided to add that letter to the existing complaints. I (Lt. Tim Stankey 1416) attached the correspondence to this complaint and it is labeled "[REDACTED] Letter 2-28-24".
