Summary:

On 3/13/24 the Internal Affairs Unit was contacted by a complainant identified as [REDACTED]. The complainant stated that they wanted to file a formal complaint against the Detective responsible for the arrest of the complainant's 10 year old grandson, [REDACTED]. The complainant identified the detective as Detective J, Granillo #3876. The complainant explained that they are [REDACTED] legal guardian,

The complainant stated that [REDACTED] was arrested on 12/5/23 and charged with Assault and Kidnapping and was accused of stabbing another child. The complainant stated that the charges were dismissed without prejudice the following day. The complainant does not think that Detective Granillo conducted a thorough investigation and believes that if he would have contacted the complainant at the beginning of the investigation, then her grandson would never have been arrested. The complainant claimed to have evidence that her grandson was at home during the time of the incident. The complainant believes that Detective Granillo was untruthful with her regarding CSPD contacting the school district her grandson attends to obtain information about [REDACTED].

The complainant stated that neither them nor their grandson were provided with a standard Miranda Advisement prior to questioning when her grandson was questioned about the case. The complainant also believes that Detective Granillo used deceptive tactics during the interview and that the officers that transported [REDACTED] to the detention center interviewed him without the complainant present. The detectives that transported [REDACTED] were identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

The complainant knows that another suspect has already been identified and arrested but they feel that damage has been done to their grandson that will stay with him for the rest of his life. The complainant stated that they have had the case expunged.
