The following information was provided to me by Lt. Pitt:

On January 12, 2026, at approximately 0811 hours, Deputy Jordan Bandt responded to a Sexual Assault on a Child call for service. During this response, he was presented with a cellphone that was reported to contain Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM). Deputy Bandt completed an initial report in which he documented that the cellphone was placed into evidence; however, the cellphone was not submitted into evidence prior to the end of his shift.

Additionally, Deputy Bandt was advised by the victim's mother that she had previously been the victim of a sexual assault. Deputy Bandt informed her to contact Dispatch to request a report, as he was nearing the end of his shift.

Hi Sheriff Roybal. I am filing a complaint against Deputy Bandt for failing to issue a ticket when five videos were provided to him. Four of the videos show a timestamp of only a few minutes apart after [REDACTED] came into the subdivision late at night (waking me up) revving loudly, got to his house next door to mine, was there for only a few minutes and then left revving as loud as he could. Deputy Bandt's response to refusing to issue the ticket was "because he could not prove intent" which is a lie. The timestamps on the videos prove the intent. The file videos prove that the person breaking the law was doing so intentionally and woke me up two of the three dates that he was revving in front of my house.

I have called the Sheriff's office multiple times on this neighbor and he has never been ticketed even after refusing to tell the truth to the Deputies.
