On Friday July 16, 2021 I received a phone call from Deputy Josh Cabello asking for permission to leave his shift due to him being unable to locate [REDACTED] whereabouts. I allowed him to leave. At around 11:30 pm I received a phone call from the Pueblo Police Department letting me know that they were looking for Josh Cabello for a domestic violence related issue, and that they would be seeking a warrant for his arrest, for Third Degree Assault and False Imprisonment.

On Sunday July 18, 2021 I was notified that Josh Cabello had been arrested on the Pueblo Warrant and was now in the Pueblo County Jail.

On Monday July 19, 2021 at around 2:30 pm I watched Josh Cabello's advisement in Pueblo County District Court via an internet connection. The presiding judge held Josh on a \$5000.00 bond and issued a protection order that disallowed Josh from possessing a weapon.

Josh Cabello is a probationary employee of the Crowley County Sheriff's Office and as such will be terminated upon his return to duty as he is now unable to perform his duties.
