Affiant Hugo Juarez, a Deputy Sheriff with Conejos County Sheriff's Office, being duly sworn, say, under penalty of perjury, that the following probable cause for the arrest of the above-named defendant does exist, and that all information contained herein is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge

Affiant is a peace officer employed with the Conejos County Sheriff's Office, in the County of Conejos, for the State of Colorado. In the course of the Affiant's duties as a peace officer, the Affiant had an occasion to investigate a complaint of **a Hit and Run** which was alleged to have occurred within the County of Conejos, and the State of Colorado. Based on the investigation, the Affiant believes, to the best of the Affiant's knowledge, information, and belief, that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant has committed the crimes of **Felony Menacing X 4, Prohibited use of a weapon, Obstructing a peace officer.**

Affiant states that the facts are known to the Affiant which establishes probable cause to believe that said the criminal offense was committed, and that said the offense was committed by the above-named defendant. Your affiant has been duly employed as a law enforcement officer for 6 Months and is currently employed with the Conejos County Sheriff's Office and was so employed at all times relevant to this affidavit. Your Affiant compiled the information in this affidavit during the course of a criminal investigation. All locations in this affidavit are within Conejos County, Colorado unless specifically noted otherwise.

On April 17, 2026, Your Affiant, Deputy Hugo Juarez, a peace officer employed with the Conejos County Sheriff's Office, was on duty, in full uniform, and within my jurisdiction in the County of Conejos, for the State of Colorado. Your Affiant had a body-worn camera during the investigation. In the course of your Affiant duties as a peace officer, your affiant was advised of by the Alamosa Colorado State Patrol Dispatch Center of an incident which occurred at on 9th West Ave and Main st in Antonito involving a vehicle striking a fence approximately at 7:51 P.M. Upon arriving in the area your Affiant didn't see any signs of damage in any of the residence. Your Affiant was able to call the reporting party later identified as Maria Vigil (D.O.B. 12/12/1959), Maria had described her residence which was located on the 800th Block of Main Steet on the East and is currently a resident of this address. When your Affiant spoke with Maria which she didn't witness the incident, but another female party later identified as Ronica L Lopez (D.O.B 12/14/1982) who had showed up shortly after did. Ronica was able to get a license plate number and also a description of the vehicle, which they described the vehicle as a Ford F-150 maroon in color with a Colorado plate number of CGH-Q51. According to Ronica's statement she was across the street at the Family Dollar which she referred to the

Dollar store. Ronica had witnessed the vehicle drive right through the train tracks, and through the fence. Ronica said the party driving the truck, who was a male party had looked around, didn't get out of the truck and reversed the truck out of the fence. The male party had drove around and went straight to the Family Dollar. According to Maria the male party wasn't able to go into the store and the male party might be under the influence. Your Affiant ran the Plate through the Alamosa Colorado State Patrol Dispatch Center, it came back to the registered owner Joshua Michael Jiron (D.O.B. 3/19/1984) to and address of 607 Pine Street located in Antonito Colorado.

Your Affiant along with Deputy Eduardo Reyes who also works for the County of Conejos went to the residence to try to make contact with the party. Upon arriving at the residence, your Affiant observed the vehicle matching the description and the plate number parked by the driveway with the lights on, but there wasn't any party in the vehicle. Your Affiant had tried to make contact, by knocking on the door but there was no answer. After numerous attempts by Deputy Reyes and your Affiant, a male party had came out for the South side of the residence. The male party who identified himself as "Don Jiron" later was identified as Donald Jiron (D.O.B 4/26/1959), and explained to your Affiant that he wasn't the owner of the vehicle on the driveway. Don had further explained that it was his nephew's truck who said Joshua. Joshua had came out of residence, your Affiant had asked Joshua who was driving the truck earlier which Joshua he was. Your Affiant explained to Joshua the incident involving his vehicle, Joshua had denied driving the vehicle into the fence. Joshua did say that he was at the Family Dollar earlier. Your Affiant had asked Joshua if he had been drinking which Joshua did confirm. Your Affiant had asked Joshua to get his drivers license and documentation for his vehicle, which Joshua went into his residence, meanwhile your Affiant was writing a summons for the incident. Your Affiant had heard over the radio that Deputy Reyes had asked for Deputy Julian Rodriguez who also works for the County of Conejos. As your Affiant was writing the summons, and Deputy Rodriguez was speaking with Joshua your Affiant heard Deputy Rodriguez say he has a gun. Your Affiant had stepped out of his unit; Deputy Reyes had mentioned that he could see a visual of Joshua, the residence had windows in which Conejos Deputies could see the east side room which looked like a common area. Deputy Rodriguez asked Joshua to come out of the house giving him commands. Joshua Refused to do so. Your Affiant observed Deputy Skylar Moran who also works for the County of Conejos also on scene, but was unsure when he showed being that your Affiant was focused on the residence. Your Affiant had noticed a older female walk into the room and also Joshua who was sitting on a chair. Based on the suspect's actions and visible firearm, your Affiant believed Joshua posed an imminent threat of serious bodily injury to himself and other Deputies as well as the other individuals inside the residence. Not knowing what Joshua might do next with the firearm, moments after we observed Donald going into the residence, Joshua had started shoving Donald. Deputy Moran and your Affiant along with Deputy Rodriguez behind, had went into the home and put Joshua in custody. Joshua was resisting, and during the arrest Joshua had landed on the older female present. Once Joshua was in custody, your Affiant had taken the rifle for evidence.

Affiant states the following, which established probable cause: That your Affiant believes that probable cause exists to believe **Joshua Michael Madril** committed the crimes of; **Felony Menacing X4 18-3-206(1)(a) which states on CRS A person commits the crime of menacing if, by any threat or physical action, he or she knowingly places or attempts to place another person in fear of imminent serious bodily injury. Prohibited use of a weapon 18-12-106(1)(d) a person commits a class 1 misdemeanor if: subsection (d) the person has in his or her possession a firearm while the person is under the influence of intoxicating of a controlled substance, which Joshua did admit to having alcoholic drinks. Obstructing a peace officer 18-8-104(1)(a), Joshua did failed to listen to commands as he was in the residence asking him to come out.**
