## Memorandum

Re: Personnel complaint CC2020-0018, Deputy [REDACTED], Deputy [REDACTED], Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy [REDACTED]

After reviewing the reports and speaking with the involved mentioned Deputies, the call is reference to an in-progress felony menacing. Under the circumstances, nature, and the priority of the call, Deputy [REDACTED] Deputy [REDACTED] Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy [REDACTED] exited their separate vehicles, and were absent of face masks / face coverings. Not knowing if there is a gun and a suspect still absent, it would be difficult to respond back to their patrol vehicles and locate a mask for officer safety reasons.

None of the reports mention speaking with any neighbors next door and across the street (Witnesses to the incident). Providing statements, as mentioned by [REDACTED], and being denied, due to the deputies not wearing masks.

The mention of [REDACTED] requesting a face mask is not mentioned. Deputy [REDACTED] report advises he was denied access to the home by [REDACTED] wife. Deputy [REDACTED] supplemental report reflects that [REDACTED] requested his cell phone to be collected from his wife, in which he was notified that it was.

Under the Executive order D 2020 138 Amending and extending executive orders D 2020 039, D 2020 092, and D 2020 110 ordering individuals in Colorado to wear non-medical face coverings, page 3 of 4, section M, sub paragraph 6, "Individuals who are actively engaged in a public safety role such as law enforcement, fire fighters, or emergency personnel" are exempt from the requirements while performing their duties.
