## MEMORANDUM

**TO: Commander Robert Nanney**  
**FROM: Sergeant Jeromy Goodson**  
**DATE: October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020**  
**SUBJ: Inmate [REDACTED] alleging intimate relationship with Deputy Juan Pacheco**

### Summary:

On 10/25/20, I, Sgt. Jeromy Goodson was on duty at the Adams County Detention Facility, 150 N. 19<sup>th</sup> Ave. Brighton, CO 80601. I received a statement form in my mailbox from [REDACTED]. The statement spoke about inmate [REDACTED] telling her that he was having an intimate relationship with Deputy Juan Pacheco.

[REDACTED] had two quotes in her statement made by [REDACTED] which were: “having an inmate relationship with a deputy,” and “It was happening outside of here and then I came here and found out he’s a deputy. He said he was going to leave his wife for me.” [REDACTED] then confirmed it was Deputy Pacheco.

I later discovered that there was a grievance in the Keefe system that [REDACTED] submitted on 10/16/20 at about 2354 hours. It stated:

“ME AND SHERIFFE PACHECO IN B MOD HAVE HAD A INTIMATE RELATIONSHIP AND I FIGURED YOU WOULD WANT TO KNOW AS HE IS NOW ‘STRAIGHT’ AGAING WOW FUCK MY LIFE WHAT A MESS THIS IS AND A TOTAL HEART BREAK IM SO UPSET [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] AS A PUNISHMENT FOR PULLING HIS CARD AND TAKING HIM OUT THE CLOSET”

[REDACTED] later added to his grievance on 10/21/20 at 0851 hours. It stated: “and now received another write up for me speaking the truth on him”

Prior to these grievances or statements that were made I was aware of behavioral issues regarding inmate [REDACTED] Deputy Pacheco had disciplined [REDACTED] by taking away his day

space on 10/13/20. This was due to [REDACTED] behavior on 10/12/20. Despite disciplining [REDACTED] the night shift let [REDACTED] out for his hour of dayspace. Deputy Pacheco spoke to me and Sergeant Jason [REDACTED] about the lack of consistency between shifts which we agreed to address. Deputy Pacheco sent us an email explaining what he did and why per Sgt. [REDACTED] request.

The email was sent on 10/14/20, at approximately 0833 hours. It speaks about [REDACTED] behavior on 10/12/20 in which he throws a bucket of dirty mop water underneath another inmate's cell. It also speaks about how removing an hour of dayspace is an effective tool with someone who is in administrative segregation.

I also noticed a "General Information" entry into [REDACTED] Jail Management System profile. The note said that he should not receive day space on 10/13/20 due to his actions on 10/12/20. It then explained the actions that caused him to lose the hour of dayspace.

On 10/20/20, at approximately 1815 hours, [REDACTED] refused to lockdown from his dayspace. Deputy Pacheco requested that additional Deputies respond to the module. I was present along with Sgt. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was on the phone and refusing to lockdown, telling us to wait. It wasn't until several more Deputies were outside of the door that [REDACTED] slowly walked towards his cell while yelling at us. Deputy Pacheco wrote [REDACTED] for several rules violations due to his behavior.

I spoke to Deputy Pacheco about the allegations that [REDACTED] made. Deputy Pacheco said that [REDACTED] was mad that he didn't get his way and was now making false allegations against him.

The timeline is as follows:

10/12/20 – [REDACTED] throws dirty mop water under another inmate's cell  
10/13/20 – Deputy Pacheco attempts to remove his day space as punishment, night shift grants it despite a JMS entry explaining the punishment  
10/14/20 – Deputy Pacheco successfully removes [REDACTED] dayspace as punishment  
10/15/20 – [REDACTED] alleges to [REDACTED] staff of a relationship with Deputy Pacheco  
10/16/20 – [REDACTED] writes a grievance on Keefe alleging a relationship with Deputy Pacheco  
10/20/20 – Deputy Pacheco writes up [REDACTED] for failing to lock down that day  
10/21/20 – [REDACTED] adds to his grievance

On 10/26/20, at approximately 1700 hours, I went to B module, Pod 1, to speak to [REDACTED]. He was currently out on his dayspace. I asked if he would like to speak to me privately and he asked, "For what?" I told him that it was about his grievance regarding Deputy Pacheco. [REDACTED] smiled, laughed, and then said, "Nah, I'm good." I confirmed that he didn't want to speak to me, and [REDACTED] continued to laugh and said, "No, that's done."

The allegations [REDACTED] made came after punishment that Deputy Pacheco issued. There was no tangible evidence that [REDACTED] statements were true. Based on this information and [REDACTED] laughing at the fact I wanted to speak to him regarding his allegations I find that his allegations were false and this complaint should be closed at intake.
