Subject: recommendations for informal investigation #120135

On 052021 at about 1100 hours Sgt. Tim Jungclaus conducted an audio/visual recorded interview with inmate ██████████ regarding a grievance submitted on 051421. During the course the interview (his primary complaints about his medical treatment) ██████████ stated that on the previous Tuesday (possibly 051821 or 051221) he asked an unidentified deputy (██████████ stated in his interview that he did not know who it was) for a kite and was told that they were out of kites, and supply would bring them at a later date. ██████████ said on Wednesday (possibly 051221 or 051821) he asked Deputy Pacheco to let him know when supply brought kites to the module. ██████████ said Deputy Pacheco told him they had plenty of kites. ██████████ stated that Deputy Pacheco said something to the effect of "don't call him in and get his post taken". ██████████ then discussed further complaints about medical issues and then complained that he was moved because the detectives told the module officers to move him and he felt that could be a form of harassment from the module deputies or detectives. ██████████ then asked Sgt. Jungclaus if there was a violation of rules for Deputy Pacheco persuading him to not make complaint about the unknown deputy. Sgt. Jungclaus then referred the complaint back to the Jail Division since, if proven, violation of 201.33: Citizen Complaints; is a level three violation that can be resolved informally.

I was given the complaint on 060321 by Jail Division Chief Chris Laws. I reviewed the interview and associated documents. I then conducted an audio recorded interview with Deputy Pacheco on 060821 at about 0755 hours. I explained to Deputy Pacheco the nature of the complaint and asked him if he recalled a conversation with ██████████ asking about the kites being available in the module or if supply was bringing them. Deputy Pacheco said he did recall the conversation. Deputy Pacheco said he remembered telling ██████████ that they had kites and would provide them at meals. Deputy Pacheco said he told ██████████ in a joking manner that he should make a complaint and get the other deputy's post taken (Colorado POST). Deputy Pacheco said he and ██████████ laughed and he went on with his daily duties. Deputy Pacheco said he and ██████████ frequently joke about the number of grievances and law suits that ██████████ files. Deputy Pacheco says that anytime that ██████████ approaches him in a serious manner he speaks and treats ██████████ in a serious manner as well. Deputy Pacheco said he has never refused or obstructed ██████████ ability to make a complaint or access to kites (aside from only providing them during meal times). Deputy Pacheco said he did not tell ██████████ not to make a complaint; rather, told ██████████ to make a complaint in a joking manner.

Deputy Pacheco says he has a good working relationship with inmate [REDACTED] and they do talk to each other in a joking manner unless the conversation turns serious.

In review of the complaint I do not find a preponderance of evidence to prove that Deputy Pacheco was attempting to influence or impede [REDACTED] ability to make a complaint. In fact, Deputy Pacheco consistently provides kites to [REDACTED] if requested. Lastly, [REDACTED] said he was not planning to make a complaint on the unknown deputy who allegedly miss informed him about the availability of inmate kites. I do not recommend further investigation of this complaint.
