I had an encounter with Justin Ellis on Friday that came off very unprofessional and frankly rubbed me the wrong way. It was after 5 and there was a gentlemen who walked into the vestibule. He needed help so I went out to the door to help him because the doors had already locked for the day and I didn't want to let him in the lobby after-hours. He explained that there was an incident at King Soopers where he was hit and the guy who hit him got all sketchy and left so he came here to potentially make a report and/or get advice. I walked to the back to see if there were any officers available. [REDACTED] and Justin were all sitting back there and I knew [REDACTED] was getting ready to leave in 40 minutes so I looked at Justin and asked if he could come to the front to help a gentlemen out. He asked, for what? I explained that there may have been an accident at King Soopers to which he replied, tell him to do it online! I said, you want me to turn this guy away? He said yes, he can report it online. [REDACTED] at that point spoke up and told Justin to go tell him, himself.
