Complaint Narrative

Complainant called station and stated that she had a conversation with a female officer on 09-30-04 outside of the Marriot hotel following a Republican party fund raiser. The complainant stated in her message, which was taken by the District Six staff assistant, Ruth Smith that a female officer had stated to her that she would not vote for President Bush because he did not like Gays and that the officer stated she was a Lesbian. The complainant also was upset that the officer was in uniform at the time the statement was made. The r/o attempted to call the complainant and has not received a call back as of yet. 10-11-04 The r/o left messages for the complainant on 10/03/04, 10/04/04, 10/06/04, 10/09/04.

Action Taken

The r/o upon receiving the complaint attempted to contact the complainant by phone and left a voice message for a call back. (10-01-04, 1700 hrs) The r/o then contacted Ofc. McAlexander with regards to the complaint and obtained a written statement on the incident. Ofc. McAlexander did relay to the r/o that the complainant approached her with regards to voting for President Bush, she then advised the [REDACTED] party that she would not vote for Bush because he does not believe in Gay Rights. Ofc. McAlexander then stated that she was Gay and she would vote for Kerry. The complainant then advised the officer that she would need to take that up with God. The r/o attempted several times to contact the complainant yet was unable to get a return call. The Officer appeared from her statement that she was polite to the complainant and only engaged in a conversation after being approached by the complainant.
