Ms. Freeman,

I apologize for the delay in getting the internal affairs records to you regarding the four prior Larimer County Sheriff's Office employees that you had requested. Upon review of the records, there were three IA records for Geoffry Preece that met the criteria for CRS 24-72-303(4)(a). Redactions have been made to these documents as permitted in CRS 24-72-303(4).

The other three prior LCSO employees you were inquiring about did not have any records that would be responsive to CRS 24-72-303(4). However, we did review the records as criminal justice records. Upon that review, it was determined that the public interest in releasing the report or simply the findings would allow for the balance of the privacy of the employee and the public interest. The findings summary for Mr. Kobi Davis is what will be provided and the remainder of the record was redacted pursuant to CRS 24-72-304; as well as Mr. Francisco Beltran's report. Both of these reports involved on-duty conduct but did not include a member of the public. Finally, the records for Mr. James Ramirez do not involve any on-duty conduct or members of the public so the records are being denied pursuant to CRS 24-72-304.

The total due for the records is \$50.75 (\$37.50 + \$.25/per page-53). We are able to take credit card payments over the phone, please note there is a service fee associated or you can mail the agency a check for the records. Once payment is received, we can send you the records electronically.

Please let me know if you are interested in the five records and what method of payment would work best for you.
