On February 4, 2025 an Internal Affairs investigation began into the conduct of CSPD Officer Louis Scott Doll. During the investigation it was revealed that Officer Doll had failed to conduct a proper investigation into a child abuse complaint. While being interviewed for this allegation Officer Doll departed from the truth to his superiors.

NOTES This internal investigation was completed on August 29, 2025 with Officer Doll's chain of command sustaining several policy violations to include Departing from the Truth. Officer Doll exercised his right to appeal this decision to a Board of Rights. On December 19, 2025 a hearing was held with the Board of Rights sustaining the same policy violations and upholding the decision to terminate Officer Doll's employment.
