Summary:

On 5/21/25 the Internal Affairs Unit was contacted by email by a complainant identified as [REDACTED]. The complainant stated that he was involved in a recent court proceeding in which he believes that Officer L. Doll #3042 committed perjury while under oath in court testimony relating to the complainant's case. The complainant believes that Officer Doll's BWC video contains clear evidence that contradicts his sworn statement. The complainant indicated that Officer Doll testified that the complainant never expressed fear for his safety and freedom, given the complainant's ex-wife's connections in the community and local government, during a call for service that Officer Doll responded to on 4/4/25. The complainant indicated that he did tell Officer Doll that he feared for his safety and freedom, given his ex-wife's connections in the community and local government. The complainant stated that Officer Doll testified that the complainant made no such statements.

Peace Officer Credibility Disclosures were not sent to the 4th Judicial District, District Attorney's Office because no arrest was made in this case and it is not criminal. The testimony the complainant is referring too was made by Officer Doll during his testimony in a hearing for a permanent protection order that was filed on 4/6/2025 under El Paso County Court Case number [REDACTED].

On 6/11/25 I, CCI Strachan 1778, received (4) transcripts of the court proceedings described by the complainant and attached them to this complaint. I then emailed the supervisor this investigation is assigned to, Sergeant J. Falls #5405, and informed him of the transcripts.

10/29/25: IA received this completed investigation, with an allegation of untruthfulness. The subject employee was terminated on 10/13/2025 for an unrelated internal investigation. Although the disposition of this allegation is that the officer was terminated prior to the completion of this investigation, the investigation was continued in accordance with DL-600-10 Notification Findings. Cmdr Cummings' disposition notes that this would have reached a Not Sustained determination, which could not have risen to a clear and convincing standard since it was not sustained, therefore there is no POST notification on the case outcome. --avl/3526
