Summary:

On 02/07/25 the Internal Affairs Unit was contacted by complainant identified as [REDACTED]. The complainant stated that they are the Property Manager for the Canyon Ranch Apartments located at 3688 Parkmoor Village Dr. in Colorado Springs. The complainant stated that on 2/6/25 and 2/7/25 an individual trespassed on the property several times and damaged the property. The complainant stated that this same individual was involved and that CSPD officers were called out multiple times to handle the situation. The complainant stated that each time the officers did nothing and told the residents that it was management's issue, and that apartment management didn't want to do anything about it. The complainant stated that she wanted to press charges against this individual and she believes that CSPD was doing "catch and release" and the complainant does not understand why.

The complainant stated that this individual was causing the tenants at the complex a great deal of fear and a total of 7 calls for service were placed. The complainant stated that the individual / suspect ultimately dropped any paperwork the officers gave him to include what the complainant believes is a summons. The complainant does not think that the responding officers handled the situation correctly.
