Summary:

On 6/01/23 a citizen contacted the Colorado Springs Police Department Internal Affairs Unit to file a complaint. The complainant was identified as [REDACTED]. The complainant states that on 5/6/23 and 6/1/23 she contacted the Colorado Springs Police Department Stetson Hills Division and attempted to make a missing person report. The complainant states that her daughter and her mother are missing, and the officers refused to take a police report or conduct a thorough investigation. The officers were identified as Officer Doll #3042, and [REDACTED]. The complainant states that she has been in contact with the Colorado Bureau of Investigation (CBI), and they are willing to assist her, but she needs a police report completed first. The complainant states that the CSPD officers were informed that fraudulent activity has been taking place and individuals are impersonating her mother and her child. The complainant believes that her mother and her child have been kidnapped, are being concealed from her, and a fraudulent guardianship case has been opened.

The complainant stated that she has been trying to get this police report filed since 2020. The complainant stated that the officers she has had contact with tell her to address this issue with the courts because there is no criminal activity to report.
