On Friday, July 21, 2017, about 1210 hours Deputies Mark Tracy, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] responded to Red Stone Park on a Restraining Order Violation (ROV) call for service. The suspect involved is named Bradley Hall (6/1/1971) has been involved in three separate ROV investigations this week involving his [REDACTED] at a soccer camp at Red Stone Park. Bradley has two active protection orders that stating he can attend his [REDACTED] sporting events but cannot have direct contact with [REDACTED]. His [REDACTED] is [REDACTED]. Below is a summary of each case.

2017-00080150: On Wednesday, July 19, 2017, Deputy [REDACTED] responded to Red Stone Park where Bradley had left the scene before Deputy [REDACTED] arrived and met with Toni Vine [REDACTED]. Toni reported she was dropping [REDACTED] off at soccer camp in her car where Bradley approached her car. Bradley opened her car door and hugged [REDACTED] and then left in his vehicle. Bradley is currently homeless living out of his vehicle and could not be located. This case was forwarded to investigations for follow up with charges of first degree criminal trespass and ROV.

2017-00080532: On Thursday, July 20, 2017, Deputy [REDACTED] received a phone report from the R/P named [REDACTED] and Bradley's [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was dropped off at soccer camp by Toni [REDACTED] mother). [REDACTED] saw Bradley's car and noticed [REDACTED] sitting the car with Bradley. Toni approached Bradley and told him he cannot be in contact with [REDACTED]. Bradley said [REDACTED] was in the car to protect [REDACTED] from the lighting. [REDACTED] got out of Bradley's car and got into Toni's car. Bradley left before [REDACTED] could call law enforcement. Deputy [REDACTED] attempted to contact Bradley without success. This case was forwarded to investigations for follow up with charges of ROV.

2017-00080863: On Friday, July 21, 2017, Deputies Tracy, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] responded to Red Stone Park where [REDACTED] called to report another ROV where Bradley was at Red Stone

Park. [REDACTED] saw Bradley and [REDACTED] were inside his vehicle. The deputies contacted Bradley and [REDACTED] in his car. The deputies completed their investigation and established probable cause to arrest Bradley. They informed Bradley he was going to be placed under arrest where he ran from the deputies. Deputies Tracy and [REDACTED] caught up to Bradley and pinned him against his car. Bradley was actively resisting arrest by pulling his arms away from the deputies and wrapping his arms around the pillar of the car door through the open windows. Deputy Tracy repeatedly instructed Bradley to stop resisting and he was under arrest. Bradley failed to follow instructions where Deputy Tracy gave Bradley two knee strikes to his right leg in the common peroneal area without effect. Deputy [REDACTED] was on Bradley's left side and took control of his left arm and then conducted an arm bar take down. While on the ground Deputy [REDACTED] maintained control of Bradley's left arm and Deputy [REDACTED] grabbed his right arm. They attempted to pull Bradley's arms behind him; Bradley continued to resist their efforts by pulling his arms in front of him. Deputy Tracy conducted a mandibular angle pressure point on Bradley where this allowed Deputies [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to handcuff Bradley. After Bradley was in custody he stated he had a [REDACTED] and needed his medication. Littleton Fire was called to the scene where Bradley was transported to Littleton Adventist Hospital. During the arrest Bradley obtained skinned up knees. Bradley was medically cleared and transported to DCSO Detentions by Deputy [REDACTED] and his trainee, Deputy [REDACTED]. Bradley was booked in for the following charges (2017-00080150 and 2017-00080532): Four count of ROV, restraining order violation, violation of bail bond conditions and disorderly conduct. Detective [REDACTED] asked Patrol not to book Bradley in under case 2017-00080150, as they were already in the process of seeking a warrant. During this arrest Deputy [REDACTED] obtained a cut on his middle left finger. He sought medical attention at Littleton Adventist Hospital where was treated and released to full duty.

After the call went out I responded to the scene where Lt. [REDACTED] was already on scene. After being briefed I went to Littleton Hospital with Deputy [REDACTED] to check on his injury and the status of Bradley.

I reviewed offense reports and BWC's of Deputy Tracy, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. I marked the videos right before the use of force occurs. In reviewing the offense reports and BWC I found the deputies used an appropriate of force to affect the arrest of Bradley Hall.

I completed the Blue Team entry attaching the offense reports, BWC and some photographs.
