Re: TPO involving Chief Bethel

Sir,

On 10/29/20 after asking for a continuance on the first scheduled date to hear the TPO disposition and request a permanent restraining order against Chief Mickey Bethel, the complainant, [REDACTED], formally requested the TPO be rescinded and she was no longer seeking a permanent restraining order.

[REDACTED] sent a text message to me on 10/29/20 indicating that she was still going to formally file a complaint with the Adams County Sheriff's Office referencing her interactions with Chief Bethel.

As of today, 12/04/20, [REDACTED] has failed to follow up and file an official complaint, despite providing her with the link to our website commendation/complaint form. At this point I recommend closing this case at intake. Should [REDACTED] file a complaint in the future, we do have the ability to reopen or link this case.
