

On 05-18-2022 at around 2150 hours I, Cpl. Allen Jr. was on patrol in the Town of Eaton, County of Weld, State of Colorado. While on patrol I received a text message from [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]). After reading the first line in the message it stated:

FYI..... My message to Mike Swartz. After reading the message I called [REDACTED] and stated what's going on. [REDACTED] stated that he had told Mike to stop with his messages with [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]) multiple times. I stated I was going to have to call him back. After getting off the phone with [REDACTED] I called Sgt. Rundle by phone and advised him that he should read the text message that was sent to me.

I provided Sgt. Rundle the screen shot of the message that [REDACTED] had sent me. Shortly after Sgt. Rundle advised me to meet at Chief Sturch's house in town. While on my way Officer Swartz messaged me on the MDT and advised if I could door up with him. I messaged back give me on sec. I continued to Chiefs residence. While we were talking outside the residence. Michael Swartz also known as Officer Swartz had passed by as he was on duty in his marked patrol car. Swartz proceeded east on Hawkstone Dr as we watched him drive by. After having a conversation, I left Chiefs residence. I was advised to call [REDACTED] back and get information from him. [REDACTED] provided me a phone number and a contact by the name of [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] also stated that he has messages saved on his phone pertaining to this incident. [REDACTED] also advised that other people at his gym were telling him that he needs to address the incident between Swartz and [REDACTED] which both are students at his gym.

As I was leaving the neighborhood, I proceeded West on CR 76. I observed Officer Swartz sitting on the North side of the road near an oil site as I passed him. Officer Swartz was in his marked patrol car. I called Chief and advised him that Officer Swartz was parked with his lights on outside his neighborhood.


As I was driving back to PD Officer Swartz messaged me again on the MDT and stated "now?" I called Sgt. Rundle and advised him of Officer Swartz behavior. I then later doored up with Swartz in the 10 block of Oak Ave.

Swartz stated that he felt like "ugh" and that he wanted to run something by me. Swartz stated to me that [REDACTED] had kicked him out the gym. Swartz also goes on to talk about [REDACTED] stating that there were inappropriate messages that were sent to [REDACTED]. Swartz stated that he does not know what [REDACTED] was talking about. Swartz also stated that he never said anything inappropriate to [REDACTED]. Swartz stated, "what should I do?" I stated I do not know. Swartz stated that they were just friends and that they train together. I then stated that I had to go to the PD. Swartz stated can I come. As I was talking to Swartz he seemed worried, upset and concerned.

I met up with Sgt. Rundle in the 200 Park Avenue and waited until Chief advised us to all meet at PD. Once we received the phone call, I called Swartz to meet at the PD.

I later took possession of Swartz Police ID card, NCMC card and keys to his patrol vehicle. Shortly after I was advised to give Swartz a ride home to his Greeley residence where I dropped him off at and watched him open the garage door. During the car ride Officer Swartz kept talking about the incident. I advised him to wait until everything's done.

I have no further information at this time. No Axon available.
