## Narrative

On 12/21/2018, at approximately 2100 hours, I responded to a radio call for additional deputies to respond to Module 6A reference an inmate on inmate fight. I responded to Module 6A along with my trainee Deputy Hartman. Once on scene we interviewed one of the involved parties, Inmate [REDACTED]

The interview was conducted in the medical closet between Module 6A and Module 6B. Deputy Hartman, [REDACTED] and I were the only individuals present during the interview. Both of the doors to the medical closet were closed during all questioning.

We initially interviewed [REDACTED] reference the physical altercation he had been involved in. During this portion of the interview we were interrupted by medical personnel who tended to [REDACTED] injuries. Once medical personnel cleared the room the door was closed again and the interview continued. [REDACTED] was forthcoming regarding what had precipitated the fight, but was adamant that he did not wish to pursue charges and did not want anything he told us written in reports. Please refer to ARS 18-30180 for further information reference the portion of the interview regarding the fight.

During our interview [REDACTED] repeatedly alluded to "so many" things going on in Module 6A that we were unaware of. I asked [REDACTED] if he would elaborate and tell me what sort of things were going on. [REDACTED] stated that it involved deputies and so he didn't want to talk about it. [REDACTED] expressed that he did not trust deputies to prevent the involved deputies from hearing about what he had told us. [REDACTED] advised that he had attempted to address the issue with deputies before and that nothing had been done.

I emphasized to [REDACTED] that, as an organization, we wanted to know about and fix any unprofessional or undesirable behavior on the behalf of staff. I assured [REDACTED] that we would not discuss what he told us with other deputies and would advise the proper individuals and have the issue addressed. I explained to [REDACTED] that I took unethical or unprofessional conduct on the behalf of my coworkers seriously and would handle the information appropriately.

[REDACTED] then stated that he believed an inmate and deputy were involved in a romantic relationship. I asked [REDACTED] who the inmate was and he advised it was Justice Espinoza [REDACTED] also known as "Ice". I asked [REDACTED] who the deputy was and he advised it was "Lovato".

[REDACTED] went on to state that Espinoza had been calling Lovato and having conversations with her on the phone using other inmates JCIDs. [REDACTED] provided the names or locations of three inmates whose PINs were being used:

1. James Ortega [REDACTED] - Identified by [REDACTED] by last name, cell number and as the cellmate of Espinoza.
2. Alberto Ohlmeier [REDACTED] - Identified by [REDACTED] by both last name and cell number.
3. Soren Garcia [REDACTED] - Identified by [REDACTED] by physical appearance and cell number.

[REDACTED] advised that Lovato had been using burner phones to speak with Espinoza. [REDACTED] advised that

### Narrative

Lovato and Espinoza had been speaking with each other since before he had arrived in the module in November of this year. It should be noted that Tiburon indicates [REDACTED] was moved into the module on 11/17/2018.

I asked [REDACTED] if he had ever observed any physical contact between Lovato and Espinoza. [REDACTED] advised that he had not observed any physical interaction between the two, but that they would frequently go into the medical closet or the pass-through between Module 6A and Module 6B alone. I asked [REDACTED] what he believed occurred when the two were alone. [REDACTED] would not elaborate on what he believed occurred while they were alone.

[REDACTED] went on to state that he had seen Lovato give Espinoza outside food. [REDACTED] stated he had also seen Espinoza give Lovato commissary food including bags of "Whole Shabangs". [REDACTED] advised that he knew Lovato enjoyed these.

I asked [REDACTED] to provide me with a specific date where he had observed the above. [REDACTED] did not provide a specific date, but advised that it occurred almost every week "Thursday through Saturday". [REDACTED] stated that their interactions usually occurred at about midnight when Lovato would come up to Module 6A from the Special Housing Unit.

[REDACTED] went on to state that Lovato had met with Espinoza's grandmother or mother in person at Espinoza's request. [REDACTED] stated that Espinoza's grandmother/mother had given Lovato diamond earrings as a Christmas gift from Espinoza. It should be noted that the week prior, on Saturday or Sunday during Watch 2 briefing Lovato had advised me that her fiancée, [REDACTED], had purchased the earrings for her for Christmas.

[REDACTED] stated that Espinoza had asked Deputy Lovato to bring in packages for him, but that she had refused to do so thereby angering Espinoza. [REDACTED] stated that these contained drugs to include "meth", "heroin" and "Suboxone".

[REDACTED] also stated that he normally wouldn't tell deputies about this, but that Lovato had treated him poorly recently and so he did not care if she got in trouble. [REDACTED] stated that she had spoken to him in a "bitchy" tone that he did not find agreeable.

I asked [REDACTED] if other deputies were present when Lovato was giving Espinoza food or visiting with him alone in the medical closet or pass-through. [REDACTED] advised that he had observed deputies just "look the other way" when Espinoza was given food or visited the medical closet/pass through with Lovato. [REDACTED] advised that on one occasion when Lovato had gone with Espinoza into the pass-through he was in the staging area. [REDACTED] advised that Deputy Carter was the Module 6A deputy that day and after Lovato and Espinoza proceeded into the closet he asked Deputy Carter if he was going to say something or address what was occurring. [REDACTED] advised that Carter responded by saying "I like my job."

I asked [REDACTED] if he had advised any other deputies of the above. [REDACTED] advised that he had told a sergeant, who may have been Sergeant Taborsky, (identified by physical appearance, described as being older, with white hair like "Santa Claus") about the inappropriate relationship. [REDACTED] stated that when he told this sergeant about the relationship that the sergeant loudly exclaimed something to the effect of, "You're telling me one of my deputies is..." [REDACTED] advised that he was concerned someone would hear the sergeant and dropped the issue.

[REDACTED] repeatedly advised us that his brother was a law enforcement officer and was applying to Jefferson County Sheriff's Office. [REDACTED] stated this was one of the reasons he felt the need to advise deputies of what was occurring. [REDACTED] stated that he did not want his brother to work at an agency that employed people who behaved in this manner.

At one point in our conversation Deputy Soto and Deputy Steinmetz entered the room to speak with us regarding the logistics of moving [REDACTED] to another module due to the fight. The interview was stopped and did not reconvene until they left the room and closed the door.

Upon completion of our interview [REDACTED] was moved to Module 6D as a result of the fight.

I went to Sergeant Isom and briefed him on what had occurred regarding the fight. I also advised him that there had been allegations of inappropriate activity between an inmate and a deputy. I advised him that I would perform a cursory investigation and advise him of what I found.

I then proceeded to the Work Release Front Office. There I contacted Specialist Heberlein who has access to the Securus Phone System. Specialist Heberlein was able to pull up the call log for Ortega. Specialist Heberlein observed that one of the calls appeared to have been listened to. I asked Specialist Heberlein to play the phone call. Upon playing the phone call I heard what appeared to be a conversation between Lovato and a male. Lovato appeared to be talking about her children. After approximately twenty seconds I asked Specialist Heberlein to stop the recording.

It should be noted that I frequently speak with Lovato on the phone as the two of us are good friends outside of work. I was able to identify her voice due to frequently speaking with her on the phone. It should be noted that the phone number that received the phone call above did not match the cell phone number I had for Lovato.

I advised Specialist Heberlein not to continue listening to the calls. I then went to Sergeant Isom and briefed him on the entirety of the situation. I advised him that the phone call I listened to corroborated at least part of [REDACTED] story. Sergeant Isom advised that he would contact Sergeant Walker reference the above and take appropriate action with his assistance.

I was later advised by Deputy Hartman that [REDACTED] had been taken to the Medical Unit to receive treatment for injuries sustained during the above mentioned fight. While [REDACTED] was in the Medical Unit he advised Deputy Hartman of a phone call Espinoza had made on 12/21/2018. [REDACTED] advised Hartman that Espinoza had been speaking with his wife and that the two had begun fighting over the phone. [REDACTED] advised that the fight was due to Espinoza's wife discovering Espinoza and Lovato's relationship. [REDACTED] advised that during the phone call Espinoza repeatedly told his wife to be quiet as the phones are recorded. Sergeant Walker was later advised of the existence of this phone call.

This concludes my involvement in this incident; please refer to other deputies' reports for further information.

On 12-22-18 at about 1845 hours I arrived at the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office to meet with Sergeant Felton and Captain Carmosino. They requested that I deploy K9 Bolo for a narcotic search of unit 6A unit 2. They also requested a sniff of some bags.

The bags were lined up in the Investigations hallway of the Sheriff's office. There was a paper bag with chip bags in it, a plastic Target bag with a cookie platter, a plastic bag of tamales and a black backpack. During the sniff, K9 Bolo did not indicate to me the presence of an illegal narcotic odor.

I responded to the jail and conducted a K9 sniff of 6A unit 2. All cells were checked by K9 Bolo. During the search, K9 Bolo gave me no indication of any odor of an illegal narcotic.

I responded back to investigations and spoke to Captain Carmosino. I advised her that I had no indication from K9 Bolo on the packages of in 6A unit 2. Captain Carmosino then asked me to search a vehicle in the employee parking lot. She told me that we did have consent to search the vehicle.

I deployed K9 Bolo counterclockwise around the vehicle and had no indication of any odor of an illegal narcotic. I then opened the front passenger door of the vehicle and placed K9 Bolo inside for a search of the interior. During the search K9 Bolo placed his nose on the center console and took in a large amount of air through his nose. His body began to tense up and he attempted to go to a sit position on the front passenger seat. When he did, his rear end slid off the seat and his rear legs were on the asphalt. He then layed down with his front legs in the seat and began to stare at the console. These behavior changes indicated to me the presence of an illegal narcotic odor.

I placed K9 Bolo back in my patrol unit and began a search of the vehicle. In the console area I located I located a prescription bottle for a [REDACTED]. The prescription stated that the bottle contained Vyvanse. I estimated about 20 capsules in the bottle. I also located a box of Cepacol Lozenges and a bottle of Stimerex ES which is an Ephedra. There was also a box that contained "The whole Shebang" chips. All these items were collected and given to Captain Carmosino.

I was then requested to conduct a sniff of 6B unit 2. During that search K9 Bolo gave no indication of any odor to an illegal narcotic, however I was advised that a hand search located a small amount of methamphetamine that was in a folded up card and in a book.

I also deployed K9 Bolo in 6D unit 3 for a search. Nothing was located.

During the incident K9 Bolo did not have anycontact with any subjects.

## Narrative

## CALL OUT:

On December 22, 2018 at 4:50 p.m., I responded to the Sheriff's Office complex due a callout in regards to an investigation. I was told that a source in the jail came forward and provided information that a JCSO Deputy, Myriah Lovato [REDACTED] had been having an intimate relationship with a current JCSO inmate, Justice Espinoza [REDACTED]. I arrived at JCSO Headquarters and was briefed by Sergeant Felton and Investigator Beale about what had been discovered prior to my arrival.

Myriah was to begin her shift with briefing in the JCSO Jail at 6:15 p.m. It was decided that Myriah would be called out prior to briefing and brought to the Criminal Investigations Division (CID), confronted with the allegations and conduct an interview if she was willing. Myriah was brought to CID and walked to interview room #3. Myriah was dressed in a JCSO Deputy uniform with a duty belt and was ready to go into the jail. Her weapon, magazines and any other weapons were locked in her assigned locker. (Her locker was later found to be on level 3, locker 24, which Myriah stated was the second locker in, past the bathrooms and the combination was 1-19-33. the locker contained her gun, keys to her car and her vest.) Myriah spoke with Sergeant Felton and Investigator Beale while in interview room 3. She did not request a lawyer nor did she ask to stop the interview at anytime.

During the interview Myriah stated that she had been taking her [REDACTED] ADD (Attention Deficit Disorder) medication in order to stay awake to drive home. Myriah said the bottle for the medication was in her vehicle and gave her permission to search her car for them. Myriah said there was a single pill in her wallet and her wallet was in her black backpack. Myriah gave permission to search her backpack. Myriah told the Sergeant and Investigator that she last took the medication, Vyvanse, on Monday (December 17, 2018).

I searched the black backpack that was brought down to CID. the backpack was going to be brought into the secure facility when Myriah began her shift. Inside the backpack were two JCSO radio batteries and other items that were issues to Myriah by the department. (Those items were seized and will be returned to JCSO Supply.) I located Myriah's wallet and inside was 1 blue and orange capsule with S489 and 70mg stamped on it. I seized this pill and submitted it into the JCSO Evidence Vault for testing by the Jefferson County Regional Crime Lab (JCRCL). I placed removed items back into the backpack and the bag was given to Myriah before she left the facility.

Deputy Dillman searched Myriah's vehicle and removed JCSO and Lakewood Police Department uniforms and a prescription bottle. The prescription bottle was from Safeway at 7353 Federal Blvd in Westminster. It showed prescription number [REDACTED], written by doctor Wade Markland, to [REDACTED] for 30 Vyvanse 70mg CAP SHIR, Filled on December 3, 2018, there were 18 capsules in the bottle and it was non-refillable. The bottle and contents were seized and submitted into the JCSO Evidence vault for testing by the JCRCL.

Also in the backpack were notes that contained inmate information. The notes were written in blue pen ink and consisted of court information and Department of Corrections Inmate information. These notes were seized and submitted into the JCSO Evidence Vault.

Myriah had arrived at work with a cardboard box with 10 bags of "The Whole Shabang" snack chips. these were

On January 2, 2019, I submitted a request to the JCRCL to test the drugs found in Myriah's wallet and vehicle. A copy of the submission form was sent to the JCSO Records Unit.

### DOWNLOAD CELL PHONE

On December 26, 2018, Captain Heather Carmosino contacted me and requested I respond to the Sheriff's Office to download a cell phone.

At approximately 10:20 a.m., I arrived and met Capt. Carmosino who provided me with an Apple I-Phone in a rose gold/pink Otterbox case. The phone was passcode protected so she also provided me with the passcode.

The phone was already powered on and in airplane/flight mode. The date and time on the phone matched my department issued I-Phone.

Under the about screen, I found the phone was a Verizon Apple I-Phone 8 model MQ722LL/A with an International Mobile Equipment Identifier (IMEI) number of 356701085513854, a serial number of [REDACTED], and a Mobile Equipment Identifier (MEID) number of 35670108551385. The phone also had a Subscriber Identification Module (SIM) card with an Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID) of [REDACTED]

Using the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office Cellebrite Physical Analyzer software (version 7.11.1.1), I performed an advanced logical extraction of the data on the device.

When the extraction was completed, I returned the phone to Investigator Jim Taylor.

When I generated the reports, I changed the time zone from Universal Time Coordinated (UTC) to Mountain Standard Time (MST) (UTC-7).

I then burned the extraction and the reports to two dual layer DVDs due to the file size (approx. 5.66GB).

I gave one dual layer DVD to Investigator Taylor. I submitted the second dual layer DVD to the evidence vault as a new item of evidence.

### ATTEMPT TO DOWNLOAD CELL PHONE

On December 26, 2018, Captain Heather Carmosino contacted me and requested I respond to the Sheriff's Office to download a cell phone.

At approximately 10:20 a.m., I arrived and met Capt. Carmosino who provided me with an Alcatel Tracfone flip phone and charging cable.

Under the battery, I found the phone is an Alcatel Myflip flip phone model A-405DL with an International Mobile Equipment Identifier (IMEI) number of 015114001163569. There was no micro SD memory card installed. The phone had a Subscriber Identification Module (SIM) card but I did not remove it to obtain the Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID) number.

The phone was powered off so I powered it on. I placed it into airplane/flight mode and turned the Wi-Fi connection off. The date and time on the screen matched my department issued I-Phone.

Using the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office Cellebrite Universal Forensic Extraction Device (UFED-version 7.10.1.1080), I attempted to download the data from the phone however, this model of phone is not supported for download.

I informed Investigator Wes Beale of the situation. He requested I photograph the contents of the device.

At his request, I photographed the call logs (all, missed, received, placed), the text message threads, the contacts, the emails, the photos, the videos and the files. When I photographed the call logs, I wasn't able to get the phone to access the dates and times multiple calls were made. For example, if the call log showed five phone calls were missed on December 5, 2018, I would only see the phone number with the number 5 in parentheses. When the photographs were completed, I returned the phone to Investigator Jim Taylor and explained the situation with the call logs.

The photographs were downloaded to a secure file in the Jefferson County Regional Crime Lab digital archive. I also saved a copy of the photographs to a thumb drive and gave it to Investigator Taylor.

## CALLOUT:

On December 22, 2018, at about 9:00 a.m., Sergeant Chris Felton called and advised me of a potential criminal investigation into the actions of a Jefferson County Sheriff's Office Deputy, Myriah Lovato. There was limited information available at the time, so Sergeant Felton asked that I respond to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office - Detention Facility to meet with him and Detention Facility staff members for a briefing.

I arrived at about 10:00 a.m. and met with Sergeant's Felton, Chase Walker, and Michael Denuzzi in a Detentions Facility conference room. Sergeants Walker and Denuzzi gave a briefing about what had occurred and stated an inmate, [REDACTED] had been in a fight with another inmate on December 21, 2018, and appeared to be the victim in that incident. Following the fight and investigation, [REDACTED] relayed concerning information about Deputy Lovato to Deputy Drew Oudeman and his trainee, Stewart Hartman. [REDACTED] had firsthand knowledge that Deputy Lovato and a currently incarcerated inmate, Justice Andrew Espinoza, [REDACTED] had been involved in an intimate relationship and he suspected Lovato of bringing drugs into the Detention Facility and providing them to Espinoza. Furthermore, Deputy Lovato and Espinoza were regularly talking with Lovato using a "burner" phone while Espinoza was using other inmate's Personal Identification Numbers (PIN). The other inmate PIN's used for Lovato and Espinoza's conversations were James Ortega [REDACTED], Alberto Ohlmeier, [REDACTED] and Soren Garcia, [REDACTED]. Lovato and Espinoza also spent considerable time together in the housing unit and alone.

Deputy Oudeman was concerned about the allegations from a professional and personal standpoint, as he and Deputy Lovato were co-workers and good friends outside of work. Deputy Oudeman looked into the allegations and had Detentions Specialist Karissa Heberlein check calls from the inmate PIN's. Deputy Oudeman heard a call that corroborated some of [REDACTED] allegations. Deputy Oudeman was able to positively identify Lovato as the female voice in the call.

Deputy Oudeman relayed [REDACTED] information to Sergeant Justin Isom. Sergeant Isom advised Sergeant Walker, who was Lovato's direct supervisor. Sergeant Walker notified his supervision and the on-coming dayshift sergeant, Sergeant Denuzzi.

Sergeant Denuzzi gave me a compact disc (CD) of telephone calls from December 12-13, 2018. Sergeant Denuzzi said the calls on the CD were from the Detention Facility telephone provider, Securus. The calls on the CD were of recordings of Espinoza and a female, who Sergeants Denuzzi and Walker positively identified as Deputy Lovato, later formally identified as Myriah Lynn Lovato, [REDACTED]. I briefly reviewed some of the calls on the CD and they were indicative of a personal relationship with talk of daily activities and family issues. The phone number Espinoza called during their conversations was [REDACTED]. According to Securus records of [REDACTED] there were 513 attempted calls with 188 calls completed from the Detention Facility dating back to November 11, 2018.

Sergeant Felton and I researched Lovato and found she was hired as a POST certified Jefferson County Deputy Sheriff on January 7, 2016. Lovato had been assigned to Detentions during her career and her 2018 schedule was three 12 hour shifts Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 6:15 p.m. to 6:45 a.m. the following day. Lovato

was found to work overtime occasionally on Sunday nights following her scheduled shift. A review of assignments showed Lovato was primarily assigned to the Special Housing Unit (SHU), but would work overtime as a level 6 and 7 floater "escort." which gave her access to visit Espinoza during her shifts and on breaks. Sergeant Denuzzi identified several of Lovato's overtime shifts where she was an "escort" as November 4, November 11, November 25, December 9, and December 16, 2018. In speaking with Sergeant's Walker and Denuzzi, they advised Lovato was "squared away" when she was hired, but seemed to be withdrawn lately.

Espinoza was a housing unit "worker," referred to as a module worker. Espinoza would have additional privileges not available to other inmates, such as extra freedom of movement within the housing unit because he was a module worker.

Based on the information above, a criminal investigation was launched into Lovato's actions.

## Narrative

On 12-22-2018 Sgt. Denuzzi had me assist him with reviewing recorded inmate calls from the Securus Technologies Secure Call Platform for an internal investigation. The calls of interest were to an unregistered phone number [REDACTED]

As I assisted Sgt. Denuzzi with listening to the calls they were from a male inmate in 6A unit 2 to a female party. As the calls played the females' voice was familiar to me but I could not immediately remember where I knew it from. After listening to 3 calls, I asked Sgt. Denuzzi if he was allowed to tell me who the female party was suspected to be. Sgt. Denuzzi told me that it was, "Deputy Myriah Lovato." It then became clear to me why the voice was familiar to me.

During 2017 I worked with Deputy Lovato. Deputy Lovato and I both worked Friday, Saturday, Sunday Watch 2. She was assigned to the Special Housing and Medical Unit while I was on the normal operations team. During 2017 I was often assigned to 3 Floor control, which controls the movement in and out of that unit. There was often communication between Deputy Lovato and I about inmate movement and staffing needs.

In the calls there were things that stood out to me besides recognizing her voice that added to it being Deputy Lovato. Deputy Lovato was assigned to Thursday Friday Saturday night shift and in the call on Wednesday 12-12-18 1735 hours the female party was referencing a message she was going to send for the inmate and she said, "Maybe tomorrow before I go to work." Then in the call on Thursday 12-13-18 1745 hours the female party said, "Nothing, just driving to work." which would be consistent with the timing of when Deputy Lovato would be heading to work.

### INTERVIEW WITH JAMES ORTEGA:

On December 22, 2018, at about 8:40 p.m., Sergeant Chris Felton and I interviewed James Martin Ortega, DOB: [REDACTED] reference this case. Ortega was currently incarcerated at the Jefferson County Jail, module 6A, cell 29 with Justice Andrew Espinoza, [REDACTED]. The interview was recorded, later copied to compact disc, and submitted as evidence. Complete details of the interview may be found by reviewing the CD as the following is a synopsis.

After introductions and an explanation of why we wanted to speak with him, I advised Ortega of his rights, per Miranda, since he was under suspicion of drug possession (Suboxone) pursuant to an administrative search conducted prior to the interview. Ortega voluntarily signed the written advisement waiver at 8:45 p.m.

Ortega said there have been weird things occurring in the module, 6A. Ortega cited an example in which one inmate would stay out "all day" and talk to the deputies. Ortega referenced the fact that anytime a search was conducted, the search seemed to focus on their specific cell. Ortega identified Espinoza "Ice" as his cellmate and they have been cellmates for about a month. Ortega confirmed he and Espinoza are Gallant Knights Insane (GKI) gang members and knew each other from being in prison while incarcerated in Bent County. Ortega said Espinoza keeps to himself, but has been sick the last couple weeks.

I asked Ortega about the Suboxone. Ortega said he found the "paper" next to a dayroom toilet of unit 3 after dinner and before the administrative search. Ortega is a module worker and found the item while cleaning. Ortega planned to turn it in to the module deputy at a later time. Ortega opened the paper and saw the contents wrapped in plastic. When asked why Ortega picked it up, he said "I have a habit of doing stuff like that." Ortega later said that he thought he may have been able to make some money and get \$20 square for the Suboxone. Ortega said that inmates would pay via commissary or putting money on the inmate's account.

Ortega said he has never used Suboxone and does not do drugs. Ortega said he has never seen Espinoza do drugs. When asked about how drugs are being introduced into the jail, Ortega has heard the drugs are being introduced via inmate mail. Ortega had no knowledge of Espinoza being involved in the drug introduction and

distribution.

Ortega and Espinoza are close and Ortega keeps an eye out for Espinoza. Ortega admitted to letting Espinoza use his phone PIN for about "two weeks." Ortega said Espinoza asked to borrow his PIN and he allowed it. Ortega did not know who Espinoza was calling using his PIN. Ortega said he only calls his mother and sister.

Ortega was asked about Deputy Myriah Lovato. Ortega confirmed a relationship between Lovato and Espinoza. Ortega said Espinoza and Lovato "started talking" and "hooked up." Ortega said that Espinoza "cares about her more than anything" and Espinoza is in "love." Ortega estimated Lovato and Espinoza had been in a relationship for about a month. Ortega said that he has seen Espinoza "holding" Lovato's hand and maybe "kissing," but had no direct knowledge of further sexual contact between them and had not heard Espinoza bragging about having sexual activity with Lovato.

Ortega said Lovato did not bring Espinoza anything and he has never told Ortega he was going to ask her to do so. Ortega suspected Espinoza may have been using his PIN to contact Lovato. Ortega did not think Espinoza had asked Lovato to work for him inside or outside the facility.

The interview ended at about 9:20 p.m. and Ortega was escorted from the interview room.

## INTERVIEW WITH JUSTICE ESPINOZA:

On December 22, 2018, at about 9:34 p.m., Sergeant Chris Felton and I interviewed Justice Andrew Espinoza, [REDACTED] reference this case. Espinoza was currently incarcerated at the Jefferson County Jail, module 6A, cell 29 with James Martin Ortega, DOB: [REDACTED]. The interview was recorded, later copied to compact disc, and submitted as evidence. Complete details of the interview may be found by reviewing the CD as the following is a synopsis.

After introductions and an explanation of why we wanted to speak with him, I advised Espinoza of his rights, per Miranda, since he was under suspicion of drug possession (Suboxone) pursuant to an administrative search conducted prior to the interview. Espinoza voluntarily signed the written advisement waiver at 9:35 p.m.

I asked Espinoza about drug use in the facility. Espinoza said there were drugs in the facility and were being introduced via inmates bringing the drugs into the facility when they are arrested. Espinoza denied using drugs in the facility.

Espinoza was asked about his relationship with Deputy Myriah Lovato. Espinoza said that he had talked to Lovato about "gang shit, or whatever" but otherwise they had no personal relationship. When pressed about the extent of their relationship, Espinoza said they were not talking on the phone and had no plans to get together after his release.

Throughout the interview, Espinoza was abrupt and uncooperative in providing information. Espinoza was advised to contact us if he wanted to talk further. The interview was completed at about 9:40 p.m. and he was escorted from the interview room.

## Narrative

### DOWNLOAD CELL PHONE

On January 2, 2019, Investigator Wes Beale brought me a blue Cricket ZTE cell phone in a black case along with a copy of a search warrant and requested I download the data from the device. He also provided the passcode to the phone: [REDACTED].

I removed the phone from the case and found several stickers on the back indicating the phone was a ZTE Blade X Max smartphone model Z983 with an International Mobile Equipment Identifier (IMEI) number of 863132037173454 and a serial number of [REDACTED].

The phone was powered off so I powered it on. After entering the passcode to boot the phone, I found the date and time on the phone matched my department issued I-Phone. The phone was already in airplane/flight mode and I confirmed the Wi-Fi connection was off.

Under the about screen, I confirmed the IMEI number was 863132037173454 and found the phone had a serial number of [REDACTED]. The phone number for the phone was [REDACTED]. The phone was running the Android 7.1.1 operating system with a security patch dated August 1, 2018. The phone also had a Subscriber Identification Module (SIM) card with an Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID) number of [REDACTED].

Using the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office Cellebrite Universal Forensic Extraction Device (UFED- version 7.12.1.1100), I performed a physical extraction of the data on the device. As I had to remove the SIM card for the extraction, I performed a file system extraction and a logical extraction of the data on the SIM card separately.

When I generated the reports using the Cellebrite Physical Analyzer software (version 7.12.0.128), I changed the time zone from the default Universal Time Coordinated (UTC) to Mountain Standard Time (MST) (UTC-7).

I then saved the extractions and reports to two 64GB thumb drives due to the file size (approx. 35.3GB).

At the request of Investigator Beale, I secured the phone in my desk overnight.

On January 3, 2019, I gave one of the thumb drives and the phone to Investigator Beale. I submitted the second thumb drive to the evidence vault as a new item of evidence.

## Narrative

### INITIAL INVESTIGATIONS CALLOUT:

On December 22, 2018 at about 9:00 a.m., I was contacted via telephone by Captain Heather Carmosino of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office Special investigations Section. Captain Carmosino advised me that some information had been brought forth alleging that Deputy Myriah Lovato [REDACTED] was involved in an intimate relationship with an inmate at the Jefferson County Detention Center, and that they may have had sexual contact while Lovato was on duty working in her official capacity. The Special Investigations Unit is under my supervision and is, by department policy and procedure, responsible for conducting investigations that are sensitive in nature to include criminal investigations of employees.

The initial information was brought forth by an inmate identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was being interviewed by Deputy Drew Oudeman after being the victim of an assault in Module 6A of the Detention Center. I learned from Deputy Oudeman that [REDACTED] had direct knowledge of Justice Espinoza (DOB [REDACTED]) using other inmate's PIN numbers to use the Securus phone system to communicate with Lovato on a cell phone while she was off duty. One of the PIN numbers identified by [REDACTED] belonged to Espinoza's cellmate, James Ortega [REDACTED]. The other PIN belonged to an inmate housed in the same unit in 6A as Espinoza; Alberto Ohlmeier [REDACTED].

Deputy Oudeman also learned that Lovato was the recipient of commissary items such as Shabang chips which she obtained from Espinoza. [REDACTED] told Deputy Oudeman that Lovato had frequent contact with Espinoza, stating that "Every week, Thursday through Saturday" they would meet in person in Module 6A. Deputy Oudeman advised me that [REDACTED] told him Espinoza solicited Lovato to bring in heroin, methamphetamine and Suboxone. Espinoza was apparently angry when Lovato refused to do it. Lovato works Thursday through Saturday Watch II, which starts and 6:15 p.m. and spans through the night until 6:45 a.m.

After Deputy Oudeman learned the information from [REDACTED] he contacted Specialist Karissa Heberlein who has access to the Securus Call Platform. Specialist Heberlein opened an audio file of a phone call (unknown date and time) from Ortega's PIN and Deputy Oudeman was able to discern that it was Lovato speaking with a male party. Deputy Oudeman and Lovato are friends outside of work and he has spoken with her numerous times on the phone. With this history and personal relationship with Lovato, he was able to tell me with 100% certainty that the voice was hers.

I arrived at Jefferson County Sheriff's Office headquarters at about 10:30 a.m. and met with Investigator Wes Beale. We discussed the preliminary information on this case and reported to the Detention Services Division conference room to investigate further. Investigator Beale and I both listened to a call made on 12/13/2018 from Ortega's PIN to phone number [REDACTED] which is unregistered and has Verizon as the carrier. These unregistered phones are often referred to as burner phones due to their lack of modern features and the inability to trace their origin. Listening to the phone call, I recognized the female voice as Lovato from working with her in my previous assignment as a sergeant in the Detention Center.

After querying all calls made to that particular phone number from the Detention Center, the results showed 513 calls made, with 188 of them being completed which totaled over 2,200 minutes of conversation. The bulk of

these calls were made using Ortega's (cellmate) PIN number. Using other inmates PIN numbers is a tactic often employed by inmates who want to avoid detection, and who also want to avoid spending their own account money on phone time.

The first communication attempt captured by Securus to [REDACTED] from the Detention Center was on 11/11/2018. The last call made was on 12/17/2018 at about 8:47 a.m.

Listening to additional phone conversations, Lovato and the male inmate, who was assumed to be Espinoza but not yet confirmed, would frequently tell each other, "I love you" along with other sexually explicit statements such as, "I want that dick home with me forever" and, "I wish you were here to finish me off right now."

Due to the severity of the allegation and the information that Espinoza had solicited Lovato to bring narcotics into the facility, a plan was devised to interview Lovato without her becoming suspicious. Being that it was Saturday, which is a normal work day for Lovato, it was decided that we would await her arrival for Detentions Watch II briefing which was set to begin at 6:15 p.m. and then redirect her to the Criminal Investigations Division (CID) after she secured all of her weapons in her locker. I learned from Sergeant Chase Walker, Lovato's direct supervisor, that she typically arrives for shift at 5:45 p.m. and stores her gun in a level 3 locker on the unsecured side of the Detention Center.

I advised Captain Carmosino of the above information, and she responded to headquarters along with Captain John Mayns of the Detention Services Division. Both were provided a full briefing on the facts of the case and the planned interview approach. A plan was also formulated to perform an administrative search of the Detention Center for narcotics or any evidence linking Lovato to an inmate.

## Narrative

On December 22, 2018, at 0500 hours, I began my duties as a supervisor for Watch 1 in the Jefferson County Detention Facility. At this time, I was provided with a briefing as to what occurred on Watch 2 for the night of 12/21/2018, and into the morning of 12/22/2018 by Sergeant Isom.

In Sergeant Isom's briefing to me, he advised the potential of investigators possibly being in the Detention Facility due to the discovery of phone conversations between a current employee identified to me as Deputy M. Lovato and JCSO inmate Espinoza, Justice (P-1010180). In the briefing I was told my supervisor (Lt. Marinelli) was advised of the information and I was to speak with her later in the morning.

At about 0745 hours, I received a phone call from Lt. Marinelli requesting I listen to phone conversations between Deputy Lovato and I/D Espinoza. The dates for these calls were from 12/12/18 to 12/13/18 at various hours in the day. I was told to provide specific quotes from these phone calls to my Captain John Mayns via email. With the assistance of Detention Specialist C. Tyler, I listened to several phone calls between Deputy Lovato and I/D Espinoza. I then provided Captain Mayns with quotes from various calls via email. Specialist Tyler completed recordings of these calls, which was provided to Investigators later in the morning.

At about 0945 hours, I met with Sergeant Felton and Investigator Beale and briefed them to the calls I listened to and provided them with the recordings made earlier in the day. Sergeant Felton requested my assistance for the day with confirmation of the phone calls as they were listened to.

At 1750 hours, I went to Watch 2 briefing as Deputy Lovato was reporting for her scheduled shift. Deputy Lovato had arrived and was in the Detentions briefing room. At this time, I requested to speak with her. Deputy Lovato voluntarily came out of briefing and into the hallway. I asked how she was doing and she stated she was "tired." We proceeded into the hallway when I asked if she had brought a bag with her. Deputy Lovato voluntarily said "yes, its right over here and pointed down the hallway." I told Deputy Lovato to get her bag, which she did voluntarily. Next to her work bag were two other bags. One of the bags contained several bags of Shabang potato chips and the other appeared to be a plastic grocery bag. Deputy Lovato grabbed both of these bags as well on her own. When she picked up the bag of potato chips, I asked her "do you like those things?" Deputy Lovato stated "yes, they are good." Deputy Lovato advised she purchased the ones she had on-line and she paid \$42.00 for them. These potato chips are sold to inmate detainees within the Jefferson County Detention Facility by the Keefe Corporation. I asked Deputy Lovato where she had tried them. Deputy Lovato advised she had tried them in the facility as "a guy upstairs" had given her some. I asked Deputy Lovato who was the guy. Deputy Lovato stated "Espinoza." I then told Deputy Lovato that we were going to the Investigations Division as they needed to speak with her. Deputy Lovato stated "okay," and continued to walk voluntarily to the Investigations Division. Once we arrived at Investigations, I advised Sergeant Felton Deputy Lovato was in the hallway. This was my last contact with Deputy Lovato.

## Narrative

### Investigation - Review of Calls

On December 27, 2018, JCSO Investigator Jennifer Jones and I assisted with this case by listening to phone conversations over the Securus Technologies call system. Investigator Wes Beale advised us that some phone calls had already been listened to, where they were able to identify the female as Myriah Lovato, [REDACTED] and the male as Justice Espinoza, [REDACTED]. The following is a synopsis of the calls I listened to and is not a transcript of the conversations, please refer to the original call recordings for complete details. The first set of calls I listened to were from November 18-24, 2018. The second set of calls were from December 2-8, 2018 and the last from December 16-22, 2018 using phone numbers [REDACTED]

11/18/2018 @ 20:02:37-20:17:01 hours - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The conversation starts out with the female being upset with the male for not doing a visit that was planned. The male tells the female that when he sends someone to do something, it gets done. The female is angry and replies that she has a "role to play too" and she has a "double edged sword" sticking in her. The rest of the conversation mostly consists of the two declaring their love for each other, then the female hangs up after the male states they are lockdown.

11/18/2018 @ 20:18:02-20:32:19 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The male calls back one minute later and asks how the male was able to make a call if they were on lockdown, to which the male replies it's because the "pigs" are scared of him. They talk about how the facility is on lockdown because of staffing levels. Later in the call there is a child making noise in the background and the female says, "Stop [REDACTED]. Stop. [REDACTED]." The two continue to talk about their relationship and how the male doesn't want to be away from the female. The female talks about how she is making a lot of sacrifices to be with the male, who doesn't know what it's like to walk in her shoes. The two continue to bicker throughout the conversation about the female not wanting the male to believe she is naïve.

11/18/2018 @ 20:34:42-20:46:12 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

This conversation starts with them talking about their day, where the male states he was depressed all day because of the female. The male says he saw the female pull into the parking lot at the beginning of the day where she comes into the building smiling, to which the female tells the male that he is the reason she smiles. The male talks about how he cares for the female and around the 08:03:00 mark the male states, "My mom will tell you", to which the female responds that she spoke with his mother earlier in the day, right before talking with the male.

11/19/2018 @ 09:48:56-09:55:37 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

During this conversation the female starts by telling the male she is at Target with her grandmother and kids. The female talks about the kids for a while before telling the male that she called his mother this morning because she thought she missed a call from him. The conversation goes back to the kids, which the female only refers to as

"the little one" when talking about how he is sick. The female says she always wanted a girl, but thinks she was meant only to have her boys. The rest of the conversation centers around the children and end with the female asking the male to contact her around 1:00 p.m., or 8:00 p.m. to talk some more.

11/19/2018 @ 20:33:46-20:47:57 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

After greeting each other the female starts out by telling the male about her kids being sick all day. The male asks about "the new baby", to which the female replies that there is no new baby and she can't do it again. The male then asks who is going to "bust my bubble" and adds, "after you all in agreement." The two banter back and forth before the female changes the conversation to what she is going to buy her kids for Christmas, saying she's getting some Air Jordan's for her older son. The conversation turns to how the male attended "AA" in the jail to see all his "little ducklings", and then changes again when the female states she had a hard day. The male replies that he has something "hard" for her and she tells him to come home for it then. The two talk about having a child together, with the male saying he will give the female a girl and then she can be done having kids.

The male then asks about getting some mail, and the female says she has to go to the post office the next day because she was too busy. After talking a little about the female's grandmother, the male changes the conversation to talk about how much he cares about the female and how it scares him to care so much, and turns him on as well. The male then talks about who is calling and says he isn't calling anybody, to which the female responds, "Let me find out" and says she'll "turn into a stalker real quick." The male adds, "we're both fucking out there" to which the female agrees twice.

The male tells the female that she has her work cut out for her with him and later adds that he is super jealous and possessive. The male starts talking to the female about her personal space and not allowing anyone in her space, but him. The male then refers to someone else who was in the female's personal space the other day, which got him upset. The female tells the male that they are only as far as they want it to be because she made the decision. The female adds that if she just wanted to bat her eyes and walk away, she would have. The conversation concludes when the one minute warning airs from Securus, so the male tells the female he will call her right back.

11/19/2018 @ 20:49:29-21:04:02 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The two continue their conversation by talking about clothes and the male cutting his hair. The male continues with how he misses the female, which makes him "act up". The male later asks for pictures of the female, which she tells him "no" because she doesn't want anyone to see them when "they toss your room". The female adds that she doesn't want the male's cellmate seeing her pictures either.

The conversation shifts to religion and the two share their thoughts about different practices. The male tells the female that he prays to saints, which makes so many things fall into his hands, and the female replies, "Like me?" The male then tells the female to guess who he has spoken to that day, to which the female guesses the male's mother and herself. The male tells the female she is right, and the female says that she texted his mother earlier in the day asking if she had heard from the male. The conversation then shifted back to religion and how the male believes he can have anything he wants if he asks for it.

The male tells the female all he wants is his "baby girl", to which the female replies that the male will end up having a boy. The male says he will take what he can get, and he just wants it with the female. The female asks the male why he loves her so much, and she tells him it's because she is his mother's favorite. The male later states that he wants the female to give him mouth-to-mouth, to which she tells him that she would do it. The female then tells the male that she loves him because he makes her happy, and the Securus warning airs that there is one minute remaining. The female tells the male to call her right back and the conversation ends soon after.

11/19/2018 @ 21:04:59-21:17:21 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The new call starts right where the previous left off, with the female telling the male why she loves him. The conversation shifts when the male tells the female that he thinks she likes having control over him. The female

denies liking having the control, and tells him that she is just scared of getting hurt. The male mentions something about the female "going with my mom", and the female responds that she talks to his mother more than she talks to the male. The female adds that she's been waiting for someone like the male for a long time.

The male later states that he sometimes thinks about faking a seizure just so he can get moved to another unit. The male then talks about how he is supposed to get out of jail in a month, and says he has been "working" a lot and adds, "if you know what I mean." The male says he is putting a lot at risk for the female, but he doesn't care about anyone else's opinion. The female tells the male that "it's not like anyone says anything", to which the male replies that no one is going to say anything either. The male tells the female that he has his "people covered up." The conversation concludes with the female asking the male to call her back in 10 minutes because she has to put her older son to bed.

11/19/2018 @ 21:29:23-21:44:23 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The male called the female back about 12 minutes later and they start talking about missing each other, which turns into the two talking about having a child together. The conversation then shifts to each of their kids and then the male changes the conversation again talking about how ungrateful people around him are.

The two then talk about how they want to be with each other and anyone else would be a "down grade". The male says he is happy where he is at, saying, "I don't need to look nowhere else, I'm Gucci gang. Shit." The male adds, "I call my GiGi and I'm good." The female then asks the male what his mom thinks about him calling her back the nicknames, to which the male replies, "It's tight huh? You like it." The female says she likes the names and they make her laugh. The male responds by telling the female that his mom "goes with the flow, she's a G." The female asks, "oh yea?" and the male tells her to "run with it."

The male then asks the female to send pictures, but the female denies the request. The male then tells the female to "be creative with it" and tells her that no one is going to see them.

The male later asks the female about believing in a higher power and asks if he gave her something, would she keep it with her, to which she says, "yes, why wouldn't I?" The male tells the female that he is going to have his mom give her something. The male continues and tells the female to tell his mother that "she is there" and that she has "faith in her". The female then tells the male that she just wants him to love her forever. The two then talk about a plan for when the male gets out of jail, talking specifically about getting a place to live together. The female then asks the male what he wants, to which he tells her that he wants her to be his sex slave. The female then talks about having more children and says the two will have all boys together.

The two are warned that the end of their phone time is a minute away, and the female asks the male to call her back right away.

11/19/2018 @ 20:33:46-20:47:57 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The new conversation starts with the two talking about trust and the female stating she does not believe the male trusts her because he didn't show up for his visit earlier in the week. The female makes a statement about the male talking with "Erica" and says she will make repercussions for the male if she finds out he is talking to her. The two then argue for a while about the male talking with other girls, and the male tells the female she is doing the same thing.

The rest of the conversation centers around the two telling each other they are in love and talking about getting tattoos to show their love. The male then explains his relationship with Erica, and how his mother doesn't like her. The female then interrupts and tells the male about how his mother doesn't like Erica, but his mother likes her.

The male makes a quick short call to tell the female that he loves her and that he will call her the next morning around 9:00 a.m.

This conversation started with the male telling the female he is in a bad mood because of drama with his wife. Most the rest of the phone call is silent until the end when the female talks about taking care of her sick kid. At the very end of the conversation the male interrupts and says he is going to the other phone and tells the female to answer her phone. The two then disconnect.

11/20/2018 @ 09:43:24-09:57:52 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

After calling back the male states he is having a "stressful day at the office", and the two then bicker back and forth before talking about how they miss each other. The conversation goes to the female's children for a while and then switches to what is happening in the jail. The male then brings up having children with the female. The two finish this call by talking about having a girl and how they would have five kids then between the two of them.

11/20/2018 @ 09:59:21-10:14:21 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The two start this phone call by talking about what they are doing, which the female says she is at Target. The male then asks again for a picture of the female, but the female denies his request again saying she doesn't want anyone to find her pictures or his cell mate masturbating to "my naked ass". The male later talks about how he wants to pull her hair, which the female says she doesn't want because her hair is "healthy and thick". Then the female asks about the male seeing her hair during her last visit. The male then tells the female that he is waiting in his window for the female and the two then bicker back and forth before the female turns the conversation back to her hair.

The male later tells the female that his tattoo for her is going to say "coldest ever", and the female turns the conversation to Thanksgiving and how her mother is "acting up lately" like a "hood rat".

The female then talks about how she forgot to send a Thanksgiving basket to her brother who is in jail at Crowley Correctional Facility, but the male quickly changes the conversation by asking the female if she wants him to tell her how special she is. The male instead talks about how he has to "take care of" stuff in the jail, so the female tells him to stay safe and adds that she doesn't want him to give specifics.

The one minute warning aired on the phone and the female tells the male to call her back immediately. The female says she wants the male to call back because she misses him and adds that she thinks it is crazy how they met. The female then asks the male if he remembered her telling him, "I got you" on that night, which the male said he did and the call disconnected.

11/20/2018 @ 10:16:09-10:30:21 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The male starts this conversation by asking the female if she remembers the day he was "gonna put your ass on the sink?" The female tells the male to "quit it" and changes the conversation.

Later in the conversation the male says something about the club, and the female asks, "You know what I'm going to buy you my next trip?" and when the male asks what, the female says she is going to get some "Purple Jordan's". The male tells the female to get his name in purple, and she replies that he should get her name in purple across his chest. The female tells the male that his mom would kill him though, but then reminds the male that she is his mother's favorite and has been since the first day they met. The male later asks the female if she knew that this Halloween was the first time that [REDACTED] has taken the boys, and the female replies that she already spoke to his mother about it, and she has already discussed everything with his mother.

The female later talks again about how it was crazy how the two met. The two talk about how it was so easy, especially under the circumstances.

At the end of the conversation the male asks the female to contact someone and tell them he needs time on the phone. The female agrees and tells the male to call her around 7:00-8:00 p.m., which he says he'll do and asks again for pictures. The female refuses to send pictures again and the male pleads, so the female says, "Maybe, we'll see." The female then tells the male to call her back in five minutes and they disconnect.

The female starts this conversation by telling the male that "she" put money on the phone and is getting money for the male's commissary. The female then starts talking about her kids and where they are going for the holidays. The female told the male that his mother was mad at him because he didn't call her, and passed the message for the male to call her.

The conversation turns to the holidays and getting their kids presents. The male later says he is going to get the female something special and asks her to have faith that he will make it happen.

The female later asks the male to tell her something she doesn't know about him, to which the male replies something inaudible about tasting the female's finger. The male then thinks for a while and asks the female if she remembers the day he was going to put her on the sink, which the female acknowledges, and the male continues saying he hit the nail on the head. The female says, "Maybe" and the male later says that he loves how the female is rebellious. The female says she is rebellious because she is her dad's only daughter and used to getting her way.

The two finish the conversation by talking about Thanksgiving and the female says she will try to stop by to see the male's mother. The male then asks for another picture and the female again says, "Maybe" and says it worries her. The male tells the female not to worry and that, "I got you", and the female replies the same.

**11/20/2018 @ 12:59:19-13:10:24 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The male then calls his mother and asks for money, and when his mother asks if it's for phone time, the male asks if she already paid for phone time and the mother replies in Spanish, "Por el otro" (For the other). The male then asks for \$70 for him, \$50 for Ortega and \$60 for what sounds like "Lopez". The mother then replies that she hopes it doesn't "bite us in the ass for these needy mother fuckers."

The male then tells his mother that, "Three deals went out today" and she clarifies, "Three?" to which the male replies, "Yea."

The mother changes the conversation saying she made two visits for Thanksgiving and then says, "And then fucking Myriah called." The mother said the Myriah asked what they told Justice in court today, so the mother asked, "Court?" and Myriah told her that she checked the website, which said Justice had court that day.

The mother said Myriah was trying to send mail to a P.O. Box for Justice, but it kept getting returned. The mother provided Myriah with the full address and told her to try again.

The two then talked about the mother trying to contact the mothers of Justice's other children. The mother talks about how horrible she thinks Erica is and tells the male to stay away from her, but says she likes the new girl, though she calls a little much. The mother says she hopes she doesn't change, and then they talk more about the kids.

**11/20/2018 @ 19:00:51-19:07:55 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

This conversation starts out with the female talking about how she is getting her kid's cold and how she is looking for Air Jordan's for her kids for Christmas.

The two talk about their relationship for a while before the male asks, "What do you get out of all of this?" To which the female replies, "I get you." The female tells the male to "get out of there" so he can show her what kind of a man he is.

The male later asks if the female sent pictures of herself today, but the female says she did not. The female said she will send some pictures of her wearing nothing except her "Jordan 9's" and then said she is kidding. The female then tells the male to wait a second while she orders something and after not being able to hear the female, the male hangs up.

**11/20/2018 @ 19:21:24-19:36:11 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The female starts this conversation by asking the male why he hung up on her previously, to which the male says

his other account didn't have money yet, so he couldn't use the time up on this account. The male said everything was taken care of, so he could talk now using this account.

The female then became upset with the male, telling him not to speak to her in the manner he did and adds that she probably talks as much "heat" as he does. The male asks the female to clarify so she repeats, "I said I probably talk as much, I probably talk as much heat as you do, they should have never trusted me with one of those." The males agrees and then the female adds, "They were dumb enough to even fucking teach me." The male then tells the female not worry and that she will go to "gang school".

They switch the conversation to the male ordering commissary and the female tells the male that she was just talking to his mother when he called back, who was stressing that she didn't get the money in his account on time.

The two then talk about the female's previous relationship, she says that she never sees the father, though they live together, because he made sure his schedule was opposite of hers to care for the baby. They continue to talk about their lives, with the female talking about the different personalities of her kids.

The female says she is getting home and asks the male to call her the next morning around 8:30 a.m. The male says he wants to talk one more time tonight, so they agree on 9:00 p.m. and then disconnect.

The male and female don't talk until the next morning, where they start by talking about how the female is sick. The two talk about their relationship and how they'd take care of each other while sick.

The female later talks about how she is going to get her lips done, and the male asks if she is going to change her name to "Gooch Gang". The two then talk about how the male's mother likes the female, and their relationships with their own mothers.

The two spend the rest of the conversation talking about how they love each other and convincing each other that neither of them are cheating.

The conversation starts where they left off, talking about not feeling guilty because they aren't cheating. The female then asks for reassurance by having the male compare her to previous relationships.

The conversation then switches to each of them telling the other how bad they want each other and how they will spend all hours of the day "loving" each other.

**11/21/2018 @ 09:07:46-09:22:04 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

When the male calls back, the two talk about how his mother likes the female and how neither women are going to let the male "do things" when he gets out. The male says he just wants to run his shop and says the female that she can help. The female asked the male what would happen if she wanted to stay at the job she has now, and asks for his real opinion. The male tells the female that he wants her to send a picture of her "pussy" and then he'll tell her what he thinks. They circle back to what the opinion the male has, and he tells the female that he thinks there is more to life than her job.

The two finish the call by talking about their relationship and how much they care for each other.

**11/21/2018 @ 09:23:11-09:35:56- to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The two start this conversation where they left off and banter back and forth about their relationship and feelings for each other. This continues for most of the conversation with the female talking about how she is sick as well.

**11/21/2018 @ 10:09:56-10:23:46- to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The male calls back at 10:09 a.m., where the two talk about the female getting her vitamins and then about her

getting her lips done.

The female tells the male that she just talked with his mom. The male asks what they talked about, so the female says it wasn't about much and told the male to call his mom.

The male then asks again for pictures, so the female tells him to get out of jail and he can have the real thing. The two then start talking about Air Jordan tennis shoes and the male tells the female to guess what kind of shoes he has, stating he is a "Westside 30 boy". The male says he wears a kind of "Air Max" shoes.

The conversation then switches to the female talking about the movies and her children again. The female spends most of the rest of the conversation complaining about her parents and family.

**11/21/2018 @ 10:24:50-10:29:08 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The male calls right back and the two discuss their relationship more and about putting in effort. They continue to sweet talk back and forth until the female says she has to go meet up with her parents so they can all get into the movie together, saying, "She's been blowing up my other phone" and says she's been ignoring her mother for the male.

**11/21/2018 @ 19:09:26-19:10:55 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The male calls back later in the evening, and the female tells him she is feeling terrible. The female tells the male that she can't hear him, which he apologizes for and says someone is having a seizure by him. The female asks the male to contact her in an hour and the two disconnect.

**11/22/2018 @ 08:54:19-09:09:06 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The male calls the female early the next day, where he finds that the female is sick. The two talk about how sick she is and about what they like about Thanksgiving. The rest of the conversation centers around the female being sick and at the end the female asks the male to call back later in the evening.

**11/22/2018 @ 21:46:58-22:01:58 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The female starts the conversation by telling the male she didn't think he would call, so the male transitions to talk about his conversation with his mother earlier in the day. The female asks if the male told his mother that they planned on having a kid together and he said he did.

Most of the rest of the conversation is the male telling the female how much he loves her and how he feels like he is on a cloud.

**12/02/2018 @ 17:06:33-17:11:50 - to [REDACTED] using PIN 00192353/0884**

The female starts the conversation by asking the male why he didn't call earlier, and then tells him that she just got off the phone with his mom. The female told the male that his mom didn't have much to say, and goes into the mother's problems with [REDACTED]

The female asks a little later if the male "talked to that dude". The male asks, "About him talking slick?" to which the female says, "yea." The male said he already took care of it and tells the female that he will tell her about it when she goes to visit him.

The male then sounds like he asks about "rotating money" and says he'll have to take some money into the "Saint". The male tells the female that he just doesn't want to have to worry about her.

**12/03/2018 @ 08:03:11-08:17:35 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]**

The conversation starts out with the female yelling at her kids about being outside, and then complains about her kids for a while.

They each ask each other about how they slept, to which the male says he had a "wet dream" about the female. The two then exchange how horny they are for each other and are thinking about being with each other.

The male later tells the female that she better take the money, and she says she knows. The male tells the female to make it happen, and she again says, "I know." The male asks if it's what she wants and she says it is. The female says she tries to go above and beyond every day to show how much she loves him.

12/03/2018 @ 08:18:34-08:32:41 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The conversation starts with the two talking about what sexual acts they will do to each other once the male gets out of jail. The female tells the male that she wants him to bend her over and spank her. The male later asks the female if she remembers the time he kissed her in the laundry mat, to which she says, "Yea". He tells the female that he likes his kisses "like that" and the female clarifies that he likes his kisses "juicy", to which the male says, "Yes".

The two talk about the male getting out of jail in 6 months and the female says she is going to tell his mom next Christmas that she is a grandma again. The male then talks about how big he thinks his penis is compared to guns, and tells the female that "you just make that shit grow."

The conversation continues in a sexual nature, until it transitions into how everything happens for a reason and they are supposed to be together.

The female then turns the conversation back into a sexual nature and tells the male that she wants him to "take care of her", so he tells her to "get your fingers wet." The two continue to talk about what they would do to each other sexually until the end of the call.

12/03/2018 @ 08:33:42-08:48:42 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

When the male calls back the conversation transitions to who has more control over the other, both stating the other didn't have a choice to choose the other. The female tells the male that she controls him and demands that he takes his wedding ring off until he puts one on her. The two then argue back and forth about who has more control again, and the female says she knows she can get "crazy" with him because he won't call the police, maybe his mother, but not the police.

The female later tells the male that she wants him to send a print of his lips and he tells her he will do it. The female talks about putting the lips on her body, referring to getting a tattoo and the male asks her to get his name too.

The two then start to argue about who has more control again. The female tells the male that he has "no fucking choice anymore" and that he is hers. After the male agrees that he is hers, the female tells him that she wants him to be home to "take care of her", sexually.

The female then talks about how pretty people tell her she is, but then wonder what is wrong with her when she opens her mouth. The male then tells the female that he calls her "his woman".

The female then tells the male that she loves his mother. The male tells the female that his mom once shot at his dad, to which the female laughs and says it sounds like something she would do. The male then detailed to the female the story about how his mom shot at his dad.

The female then tells the male that she wants to get off the phone so she can shower. The male tells the female that he doesn't want her to leave and asks again for her to take pictures for him. time she gets it done. The male continues to tell the female to do sexual acts while she is showering, until the end of the call.

The male calls back right away and continues with his sexual comments until he tells the female that he has to go serve lunch and will call her back.

The male doesn't call back until later in the evening, who is upset with him that he didn't call since the morning. The female tells him that she has been lying in bed all day waiting for his phone call, and tells him to ask his mother, who she spoke to three times throughout the day. The male tells the female that he tried calling, but she didn't answer, so the two argue about whether he tried to call or not.

The two continue to argue, so the male says he is going to let some of the other inmates waiting for the phone make their calls. The female tells the male that he needs to deal with her "throwing a tantrum" and take care of her.

When the one minute warning airs the male reminds her that he is going to let some other guys use the phone and then he'll call back. They say their goodbyes until time runs out and the phone disconnects.

The male calls back about 15 minutes later and the female starts the conversation talking about how she is so sick. The male proceeds to try to have sex with the female, who tells him she wants him rubbing her back instead. The female tells the male that his mom was super nice, telling the female to give her a call if she needs anything.

The remainder of the conversation is relatively quiet, with the male talking about random subjects here and there.

12/20/2018 @ 21:21:21-21:35:29 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The male calls back and the conversation continues like the last, with long silences and the male jumping from various random topics such as what his stripper name would be, Christmas, and how he wants to impregnate the female.

The time limit gets to the last minute, so the male tells the female to answer her phone and hangs up.

12/20/2018 @ 21:36:45-21:51:45 - to [REDACTED] using PIN [REDACTED]

The male calls back where the female tells him she is thinking about calling her grandmother to see if she will take the female to urgent care. The male changes the conversation to tell the female that he loves her until the female tells him again that she is going to call her grandmother before it gets too late.

The female tells the male that she will stay on the line with him until the call time runs out. The two don't talk much with the female mainly silent and the male talking to other inmates. At the end of the conversation the female tells the male to masturbate in the shower and then call her in the morning.

The male called back to ask the female what she said before their previous call ended. The female repeats to the male that she told him to masturbate in the shower. The male asks the female to have phone sex with him, but she says she is too sick and doesn't want to.

They tell each other that they love and miss one another, then the female tells the male to go shower and tells him to call her in the morning.

The male calls the next morning and asks the female how she feels. The female tells him that she went to the

hospital and they told her she has the flu. Most the conversation centers on the female being sick and how she feels as if she is going to die.

The male calls a few hours later and the two talk more about each of them getting a tattoo of the other's name. The conversation shifts to the female complaining about her older son and then to how she still doesn't feel well.

The male keeps trying to turn the conversation sexual, but the female doesn't feel well enough to partake and continually denies the male until the conversation circles back to their tattoos. The one minute warning airs and the female tells the male to call her right back.

The male calls back and the female asks if his mother told him everything Erica texted and told her. The male tells the female about how he called Erica and yelled at her about the situation. The female later tells the male how she plans to take her kids to the movies tonight, and then they talk about how they each can't wait for the male to get out of jail.

The male calls back later in the evening and the female apologizes for missing his phone calls and blames her older son while complaining about him saying, "I'm about to beat the fuck out of him." The female continues to complain about her son saying she wants to, "Shove his tablet up his ass."

The male accepts her apology and tells her about an inmate who has been meeting with officers in a room for about a half hour. The female asks the male if he thinks the other inmate is "telling on somebody" and tells him not to trust anyone.

The female changes the subject and asks the male what she should bring to her aunts for Christmas. The female transitions and starts to complain about her older son again. The female later tells the male that she spoke with his mom again today, but the male is distracted by whatever is happening in the jail module. The male tells the female that he was getting picked on by Deputy Gallegos again for not following the rules, so he told her that he didn't get in jail for following the rules. The female then tells the male that he should tell her that he makes the rules and therefore doesn't have to follow them.

The conversation switches to how they miss each other and the male tells the female she is not just his "side bitch", but his "forever, ever." The call then runs out of time and disconnects.

The male calls right back and starts the conversation in a sexual nature. The female tells the male she can't talk like that because she is at Target. The female then asks the male "What about my wrist?" referring to the tattoo of his name. The female tells the male that once he is on the outside and they get married she will get his last name on her other wrist so he has his full name on her.

The female later tells the male that his mother makes him sound innocent, but she really knows. The female adds that his mother was happy to see that she got her nails done in the male's favorite color, purple.

The female transitions and asks when the last time the male talked to "her", referring to his wife. The female seems to get satisfaction out of hearing his wife was upset and says she would "fuck her up." The female adds that his mother told her that he better cut the wife out of the picture, or his mother would stop talking to him. The female keeps bringing up how the male's mother was talking trash about his wife and she told her that even though she's sick, she would go "fuck up" the wife. The female adds that she told his mother, "You know I pack, Cindy? You just let me know. I got that hollow point shit. I make sure that shit stays in your body. I don't want it just to shoot through you." The female adds that it was the worst thing anyone could have done was to teach her

how to use a gun.

The male changes the subject and asks her for pictures again, which the female says she'll have to "get creative" and do for him. The female adds that it has been a while since they had phone sex too.

The female tells the male that she needs him home and they discuss how much time he has left in prison before he gets released. The male says he'll only do 33% of his time before he gets released and then tells the female he wants to "eat your ass like a cupcake." The female replies that she isn't in Target anymore so, "you can stick in my butt all the way now." They say their goodbyes and hang up.

The male calls back the next afternoon and the female complains about bills and not feeling good again. The male tells her not to go to work, but the female says she has to go to make up some money. The female complains more about her older son and her dad, before the male tries to make the conversation sexual. The female tells the male she can't talk like that because she is in Nordstrom's, where she finds a great lavender sweater she wants to get to wear for the male.

The female then tells the male that she wants to double pierce her ears so she can wear both sets of earrings and they talk about her ring size.

The female then brings up that she spoke with the male's mother again, but the male doesn't acknowledge it and continues to talk in a sexual manner until the female interrupts by singing. The call nears its end and the female tells him to call her back.

The two then talk about how many kids they are going to have and how they will never be alone because of it. The female tells the male that she can't have too many more kids because her mother is tired of taking care of her and her brother's kids all the time.

The two then talk about strip clubs, getting drunk and fighting. The female boasts about how "hard headed" she is and how she "doesn't give a fuck."

The conversation turns sexual again and the two talk about what they want to do to each other before the call runs out of time.

The male calls back and the female talks about tattling on him to his mom, who would then be so angry that he blew it with the female that she would "tase Erica to death, you hear me Justice?" The two turn the conversation sexual and talk about what they want to do to each other. The male then talks about his commissary and having so many bags of "Shabang chips".

The female tells the male to call her back once their time runs out, but the male says he needs to let other people use the phone. The female tells the male that if he doesn't call her back she will make it so no one can use the phone all night by calling the jail and telling them to do a search and have everyone locked down all night.

The male tells the female that he wants to have phone sex later, so the female tells him to call her back around 4:15 p.m. so she has time before work. The male then talks about having anal sex with the female until the one minute warning airs for their call. The two say their goodbyes and the male agrees to call her around 4:20 p.m.

The male tells the female that he has to go serve dinner and he'll call her back when he's finished and they disconnect.

## Narrative

### ARREST OF MYRIAH LOVATO :

On December 22, 2018, at about 10:30 p.m., I arrested Myriah Lynn Lovato, [REDACTED] for the crimes of Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance, Introducing Contraband - 1st Degree, Sexual Conduct in a Correctional Facility, and First Degree Official Misconduct.

I, along with Sergeant Chris Felton and Captain Heather Carmosino, transported Lovato to the Jefferson County Jail and booked her through the facility, pending the formal filing of criminal charges. I returned Lovato to the Criminal Investigations Division and released her from custody. Lovato was allowed to gather her personal effects, not taken as evidence, and leave.

It should be noted that Lovato did not show visible signs of remorse (e.g. crying, apology, etc.) for her actions during her arrest and the booking process.

## Narrative

### CYNTHIA MEDINA VISIT:

On December 23, 2018, at about 12:15 a.m., Investigator James Taylor and I went to [REDACTED] to contact Justice Espinoza's mother, Cynthia Medina, [REDACTED]. Information was received during the interview of Deputy Myriah Lovato that she had been communicating by voice call and text message with Cynthia Medina for several weeks using the number [REDACTED]. Lovato disclosed during her interview that Cynthia purchased a black flip phone "burner phone" with the number [REDACTED] and paid for the service.

[REDACTED] was a multi-unit apartment complex with secured access. I rang the number from a callbox to contact Medina and asked if we could interview her. Medina agreed and unlocked the access doors. Investigator Taylor and I went to apartment [REDACTED] where we contacted Medina standing with the door open. Medina invited us into the apartment and we sat in the living room.

Introductions were made and we explained our reason for the interview. We all talked about Espinoza being incarcerated and told Medina the investigation centered around a jail deputy's actions and that Espinoza was involved, but not a suspect. Medina was asked if she recognized the name "Myriah", "Gigi", or "Gucci." Medina said she did not know the name "Myriah" or anyone who went by those monikers.

Medina was advised that we knew she had been receiving calls from [REDACTED] and asked about the caller. Medina did not recognize the name or the number, but when pressed about the fact the deputy may have been talking to her on that number, Medina claimed the deputy, who she did not know by name, had contacted her using the number [REDACTED]. Medina said that she met the deputy once for a meal and entered the number into her contact list as "Beautiful," because Medina said she was beautiful and there were no names exchanged.

Medina did not recall specific conversations and text messages between them, but confirmed she had been

talking to "Beautiful" on occasion. Investigator Taylor confronted Medina about a text message string referencing transporting the "smallest letter" to Espinoza via the deputy. Medina did not recall the text message and had no detailed information to provide, so I asked Medina for her phone to verify information. Medina voluntarily gave me her phone, which was a black ZTE Blade smartphone.

I reviewed Medina's phone with her consent and found a text message string from [REDACTED] There was no name linked to the number. The text message string was:

Medina - December 13 @ 4:15 p.m. "Hi so the smallest letter I've ever seen is ready. LMK we can go outside."

Medina - December 14 @ 4:14 p.m. "I'm sorry was on a video visit but come by and i'll run outside."

Medina - December 14 @ 4:15 p.m. "I'm home"

Deputy - December 14 @ 4:15 p.m. "okay thanks"

Medina - December 14 @ 4:28 p.m. "Would you like a Pepsi or something to drink to take?"

Medina - December 15 @ 5:09 p.m. "Pls call me back"

I took two photos of the text string and associated number of [REDACTED] on Medina's phone. I found a profile for "Beautiful" in the contact list and linked to [REDACTED]

Investigator Taylor and I confronted Medina about the text messages and if she sent anything to Espinoza via the deputy. Espinoza denied ever sending to or receiving from Espinoza anything via the deputy. Medina said that she would not circumvent the jail protocols to send Espinoza anything and only uses U.S. Mail to send anything to Espinoza. Medina denied purchasing a phone for the deputy and said that she is on a fixed income and does not have the money to pay for phone service for anyone else. Medina accused the deputy of lying and fabricating Medina's involvement.

After speaking with Medina and advising her that the investigation would be on-going, she agreed to cooperate during the investigation and provide information as necessary. I gave Medina my business card and we left the apartment.

### INMATE ACCOUNTS AND KITES:

On December 26, 2018, I requested inmate communication to Jefferson County Detention Facility staff members, also known as "Kites," for Justice Espinoza, [REDACTED] Alberto Ohlmeier, [REDACTED] and James Ortega, [REDACTED]. "Kites" are kept on file and in an inmate's jail record. The purpose of requesting the "Kites" was to determine if Deputy Myriah Lovato had been communicating with Espinoza via the "Kite" system to avoid detection and conceal her relationship with Espinoza.

On December 27, 2018, I received "Kites" in PDF form for Espinoza and Ortega from Sergeant Rod Williams and reviewed them. Ohlmeier had not written any "Kites". I found nothing of evidentiary value from the "Kites" and nothing to indicate Lovato and Espinoza were using the "Kites" to communicate.

On December 26, 2018, I also requested inmate financial and commissary information for Espinoza, Ortega, and Ohlmeier from the Inmate Services Unit. All financial information and commissary orders are kept on file in the inmates jail record. The purpose of this was to determine if Lovato had been depositing money to the inmate's "books." I was advised that anyone can deposit money to an inmate's "books" and it can be done in-person at the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office or remotely via a website.

Later that day on December 26, 2018, I received account information in PDF form for Espinoza, Ortega, and Ohlmeier from ISU Technician Amanda Mayzes-Chavez and reviewed them. Espinoza, Ortega, and Ohlmeier had extensive commissary orders on almost a weekly basis. Espinoza routinely ordered "Shabang Chips." There was nothing in the records that specifically identified Lovato as a depositor on any of their "books." "Cynthia Espinoza" was a depositor on Espinoza's books.

Through a follow up with Mayzes-Chavez on January 15, 2018, I learned that in order to sign in to deposit money to an inmate's account, the depositor must create an account. The account includes the billing information for the depositor so the company can verify the credit card used. The company for remote deposits is Access Corrections. The website for Access Corrections is <https://www.accesscorrections.com>. A search of the name "Myriah Lovato" did not show a registered depositor matching Lovato in this case as having provided any money to any JCSO inmate accounts.

A copy of the documentation collected in this report was submitted as evidence.

**Narrative****2ND INTERVIEW OF MEDINA AND SEARCH WARRANT:**

On December 26, 2018, at about 2:00 p.m., Investigator James Taylor and I went to [REDACTED] to follow up with Cynthia Medina, [REDACTED] Cynthia is the mother of Justice Espinoza, [REDACTED] the inmate involved in this case who was involved in a personal relationship with Deputy Myriah Lovato. During the investigation, additional questions were developed that needed clarified by Medina.

I called Medina previously and we agreed to meet at her home at 2:00 p.m. for an interview. Medina was concerned about the police visiting her apartment because she lives in government housing and if the police come to the apartment, it is cause for eviction. I assured Medina that Investigator Taylor and I were in regular clothes and not uniform and staff would not know the police were at her apartment. That seemed to alleviate Medina's concern.

Upon arrival at the apartment complex, I used the callbox to call Medina and let her know we were there. Medina unlocked the access door and Investigator Taylor and I went to her apartment. Medina was standing at the door and invited us into the home. We sat in the living room and talked about the case.

I asked Medina if Espinoza was involved in the Gallant Knights Insane (GKI). Medina explained that Espinoza is listed as a GKI on "paper" when in jail, but has never been involved with the GKI and is not a gang member.

I explained to Medina that our investigation showed the number [REDACTED] had been used by a Jefferson County jail deputy to communicate with her. Medina confirmed a young, petite, female deputy had contacted her on December 5, 2018. The deputy, who Medina verified by looking at a photo of Lovato's face from her POST Academy graduation, had contacted her by phone and they exchanged pleasantries. Lovato asked to get together at some point, so arrangements were made to have lunch at a later date. Since that time, Lovato and Medina had spoken by phone a "couple times" about Espinoza, but she would not or could not recall the content of the conversations. Medina said they did not exchange names, but she referenced her as "Beautiful" in her cellular phone.

Medina believed that Lovato was a jail "counselor" inquiring about Espinoza's gang affiliation with the GKI for a placement report to accompany Espinoza during his upcoming four year prison sentence. Medina said Lovato identified herself as a jail deputy and that she worked on the "gang unit."

On December 17, 2018, Medina and Lovato went to Lunch at a restaurant called "Camargo's." Lovato picked Medina up from her apartment because Medina lost her car key. Lovato brought her baby with her and most of the lunch discussion was about the baby and Espinoza.

Medina said there was nothing suspicious about Lovato's actions and that an interview with family members seemed reasonable to the what a counselor would do in creating a placement report. Lovato seemed "all about work" and on the "up and up," so there was no reason to think otherwise.

I explained to Medina that we would like to download her phone for evidence in this case. Medina balked at the idea of us having her phone and agreed to a voluntary download of her cellular phone at the Jefferson County

Sheriff's Office the following day. The reason for this was because she has custody of Espinoza's four year son and her cellular phone is the only means of contact with emergency services if she's out and about. Medina went on to say that she saved and archived her phone data for us in case we needed it during the investigation. After discussion with Sergeant Felton, I made the decision to allow Medina to bring the phone to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office on December 27, 2018, at 8:00 a.m. for a download. Medina allowed Investigator Taylor and I to verify the records were still on her phone, which they were. Medina confirmed her cellular phone was a ZTE Blade with phone number [REDACTED]. Prior to leaving, I advised Medina to keep the records archived because they were needed for the investigation. Medina understood and reiterated her intent to bring the phone to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office for the download.

At about 6:35 p.m., I received an e-mail from Medina. Medina advised she had obtained legal advice and would no longer cooperate with the investigation and not produce her cellular phone for download. I did not respond to the e-mail.

On December 27, 2018, I wrote a two stage search warrant for Medina's apartment to recover and examine her cellular phone. I presented the search warrant to Judge Ryan Stuart and he approved it. I filed the search warrant with the Jefferson County Clerk.

I met Sergeant Chris Felton, Investigators Jennifer Jones and Paul Spokas, and Denver Police Officer Gordon Seib near the residence for a briefing. After the briefing, we went to the apartment complex to execute the warrant. For the execution of the search, we were dressed in raid gear, pursuant to Jefferson County Sheriff's Office policy. A tenant, who I did not identify, allowed us access to the apartment complex. Sergeant Felton and I went to the management office to obtain a key for Medina's apartment in the event she was uncooperative in opening the door or not at home. I spoke with complex manager [REDACTED] who provided a key to Medina's apartment. Brown confirmed Medina was on the lease and had lived there since November 2014.

At about 3:45 p.m., I knocked on the door to Medina's apartment. Medina eventually answered and I served her with the search warrant. I asked Medina where her cellular phone was and she advised it was charging in the bedroom. Medina remained with other personal while Investigator Jones and I went to the bedroom and recovered the phone. The phone was powered, but password protected. I took photos of the phone and area of recovery prior to seizing it.

I went to the living room where Medina was talking with other personal. Medina provided a bill as indicia of residency at the apartment. Medina also provided the password for the phone. Sergeant Felton was speaking to Medina about her actions in forcing a search warrant after agreeing to a voluntary download of her phone. While Medina was speaking with Sergeant Felton, I confirmed the password was correct and accessed the phone contents. The records I previously saw on Medina's phone were gone. I confronted Medina about the missing records and that I warned her previously that the records were needed for the investigation.

Sergeant Felton and I accused Medina of Tampering with Physical Evidence and she claimed her phone had been damaged, so she had it repaired at a Cricket Wireless store. Medina claimed the screen cover was damaged, so she went to the Cricket Wireless store to obtain a new screen cover. While there, the employee, who she could not identify as a black male, replaced the SIM card. Medina said that she wanted to keep the SIM card, but the clerk threw it away because there "was no data stored on it." Medina produced a receipt for her actions and the receipt shows the purchase of a screen cover and replaced SIM card. Prior to our leaving at about 4:10 p.m., Medina was warned about the potential ramifications of her actions.

I kept the phone in my possession until January 2, 2019, when I gave it to Investigative Specialist Susan Scohy for download. Specialist Scohy was able to extract data from Medina's cellular phone. On January 3, 2019, I took custody of the phone and a copy of the download from Specialist Scohy and it was kept in my possession until I submitted the phone as evidence.

I submitted the search warrant, property seizure report, and return as evidence since the search warrant is under Court seal.

## Narrative

### INTERVIEW WITH ALBERTO OHLMEIER:

On December 31, 2018, at about 4:05 p.m., Sergeant Chris Felton and I interviewed Alberto Ohlmeier, DOB: [REDACTED] reference this case. Ohlmeier was interviewed inside the Jefferson County Jail and the interview was not recorded. Ohlmeier had been incarcerated since May 30, 2018, moved to housing unit 6A on June 16, 2018, and currently assigned to housing unit 6A, cell 21.

After introductions were made and I explained the reason for the visit, I advised Ohlmeier that his personal identification number (PIN) for the Securus phone service was being used by other inmates. Ohlmeier did not know who was using his PIN and said that because the wristbands have their PIN printed on them, any inmate who sees the wristband could be making calls with his PIN. Ohlmeier said that he only calls his mother and he has only authorized his cellmate, not Espinoza, to use the PIN to call relatives. Ohlmeier was advised that Espinoza was making calls using his PIN. Ohlmeier did not act surprised and made no accusation that Espinoza had stolen his PIN for his own use.

Ohlmeier was asked about Espinoza's relationship with Deputy Myriah Lovato. Ohlmeier said that he had no direct knowledge of Espinoza's relationship with Lovato or phone calls between them while using his PIN. Ohlmeier said that he had seen Lovato and Espinoza one time, but would not provide specifics.

When we confronted Ohlmeier about Espinoza's mother, Cynthia Medina, putting money on his inmate account, Ohlmeier said that she added money to his "books" so Espinoza could bypass the commissary order rules and order additional items. The purpose for that was so Espinoza could take "care" of other less fortunate inmates by providing them with commissary items. Ohlmeier confirmed the maximum amount an inmate can spend on commissary was \$65.00 per weekly order.

Ohlmeier had nothing additional to add and did not want to assist further. Ohlmeier was sent back to his cell and the interview terminated.

## Narrative

### INTERVIEW WITH AUSTIN CLARK:

On January 2, 2019, at about 12:15 p.m., Investigator James Taylor and I interviewed Austin Clark at the Jefferson County Detention Facility. Clark is a civilian counselor at the Jefferson County Jail. Prior to becoming a counselor, Clark worked for the State of Colorado as a case manager assigned to the Denver Parole Office. Clark is on the Jefferson County Detention Facility "Gang Unit" and has been for approximately 1.5 years.

Clark had recently returned from being out of the office from December 20 - January 1, 2018 and heard rumors of this case upon his return. Clark figured our interview centered on the actions of Deputy Myriah Lovato and inmate Justice Espinoza. Clark told us the following:

Clark is the counselor assigned to housing unit 6A. Around mid-December and unknown exact date, an inmate named [REDACTED] approached Clark to relay concerns he had about contraband in the facility and Lovato, specifically, Lovato having an inappropriate relationship with Espinoza and her bringing drugs into the facility. [REDACTED] had reported concerns previously to jail staff, but the concerns went unheeded, so [REDACTED] reported his concerns to Clark. Clark in turn reported the concerns to the housing unit deputy, Jose Marquez, and did not follow up further as he believed Deputy Marquez would relay the information to his supervision to address the concerns.

Clark remembered Espinoza from his previous parole employment because Espinoza was a parolee he supervised about five years ago. When Espinoza was jailed at the Jefferson County Jail, he and Clark recognized each other. Clark recalled that Espinoza was a confirmed Gallant Knights Insane (GKI) member and believed he held a high rank within the gang.

As Clark and Lovato worked together in the "Gang Unit", information and intelligence would be shared among "Gang Unit" members. Lovato had been looking into GKI and other gang related fights among the female inmates of housing units 7C and 7D. Lovato had been talking to Espinoza and trying to get information to quell the gang

issues and told Clark, "He's giving me information." Clark said that Lovato was using Espinoza to obtain information and had been using him for a week and a half to two weeks prior to Clark going on leave in December.

When asked about Lovato's interview strategy with Espinoza, Clark said that he knew Lovato visited Espinoza a "few times a week", which he estimated to be 3-4 times weekly for the last six to eight weeks, and would do interviews alone. NOTE: Single person interviews are not recommended during gang unit training and are not a condoned practice for gang validations and interviews. Clark did not know the duration of Lovato's interviews with Espinoza, but said they were longer than his usual 10-20 minute interviews with inmates. Lovato said that she kept visiting Espinoza to build rapport and did not want to lose her source of information. Clark did not recall where the Espinoza interviews took place, but were rumored to be in the medical closet. Clark was not present for Lovato's interviews with Espinoza.

Investigator Taylor and I asked Clark if he ever saw Lovato bring Espinoza anything or share food. Clark never saw Lovato bring Espinoza anything, but said that Espinoza did give her a bag of "Shabang" chips on one occasion. Clark never saw Lovato in possession of two phones or any contraband. Clark did not see any indication of a relationship between Lovato and Espinoza, to include flirting or intimacy.

Investigator Taylor and I asked Clark if there was anything that stood out to him, now knowing the rumors of the Lovato/Espinoza relationship. Clark told us that Espinoza became "standoffish" in early December and asked Lovato why Clark was validating GKI members. Espinoza would linger near the counselor cubicle when Clark was speaking with other inmates and doing gang interviews, forcing Clark at times to order Espinoza to walk away. Clark also found it strange that Espinoza's gang associates would try to ask him details about his life, vacation, home and vehicle information, etc, which concerned him.

On December 13, 2018, Clark notified Lovato that there was a rumor she was bringing drugs into the facility and in a relationship with Espinoza. Clark said Lovato was "quick to respond" and seemed almost defensive of her actions, denying any personal relationship with Espinoza and an introduction of drugs into the facility. Clark told me that Lovato made a comment to the effect of "I'm glad I didn't bring him out of the module." Given inmates sometimes make exaggerated claims about a deputy or a deputy's actions, Lovato's response seemed "over the top", according to Clark.

On December 14, 2018, Lovato told Clark about Espinoza's gang associates being advised by Espinoza to not talk to Clark. They discussed the concern of Espinoza's associates asking about Clark's personal life and Lovato seemed genuinely concerned for Clark's safety. Clark had no further contact with Lovato after December 14, 2018.

Clark had no additional information to provide. I gave Clark my business card and the ended the interview.

**Narrative****INTERVIEW WITH DEPUTY SAMUEL VANALPHEN:**

On January 4, 2019, at about 6:05 p.m., I interviewed Deputy Samuel VanAlphen at the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office - Detention Facility. Deputy VanAlphen is a Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Detention Facility. Deputy VanAlphen works Friday through Sunday shifts, from 6:15 p.m. to 6:45 a.m. the following day. Deputy VanAlphen routinely works housing unit 6A and through the course of the investigation it was believed he may have case related information.

After introductions were made and I explained the reason for the interview, Deputy VanAlphen told me the following: Deputy VanAlphen stated that he is routinely assigned to housing unit 6A during his shifts. Deputy Myriah Lovato was primarily assigned to the Special Housing Unit (SHU), but would occasionally work overtime as an "escort". Lovato was also assigned to the "Gang Unit" and had done gang validations in housing unit 6A.

Deputy VanAlphen explained that he knows Deputy Myriah Lovato professionally. Deputy VanAlphen does not associate with Lovato outside of work, but she knows his hobbies, address, and some details about his personal life discussed through their professional relationship.

Deputy VanAlphen had heard the rumors of Deputy Lovato's actions from other deputies. Deputy VanAlphen told me that he remembered all of this incident starting around early October because of gang related issues between female inmates occurring in the housing units of 7C and 7D. Lovato would come to housing unit 6A around lockdown (10:00 p.m.) and would interview Justice Andrew Espinoza, [REDACTED] presumably for gang intelligence. VanAlphen estimated Lovato visited with Espinoza once or twice weekly and all their visits with the exception of one were within Deputy VanAlphen's sight near the "counselor desk." On one occasion, Lovato spoke with Espinoza near the housing unit 6A entry door, across from the medical closet so as to be blocked by a wall and not visible to inmates. I asked Deputy VanAlphen if Lovato and Espinoza ever met privately and he told me that he only knew of one occasion where Lovato interviewed Espinoza in a SHU dayroom alone. Deputy VanAlphen said he ignored Lovato's conversations during her gang interviews with inmates and did not know the

content of the conversations.

Deputy VanAlphen said there were several occasions when Lovato and Espinoza were at the housing unit workstation looking at a computer screen. Lovato would be viewing Tiburon mugshots of inmates with Espinoza, which VanAlphen presumed was intelligence for the "Gang Unit." Deputy VanAlphen could not recall specific dates for the visits between Espinoza and Lovato.

I asked Deputy VanAlphen if there was anything between Espinoza and Lovato that stood out as suspicious to him and he said that in hindsight, Lovato would do a walkthrough of the housing unit to check the cells and Espinoza would do the walkthrough with her. NOTE: It is not protocol for inmates to perform a deputy's duties, even under the deputy's direction. Deputy VanAlphen told me that he never saw anything inappropriate or illegal occur between Espinoza and Lovato. Deputy VanAlphen said he did not witness flirting, intimacy, or other evidence of a relationship between Espinoza and Lovato.

I asked Deputy VanAlphen about an incident that occurred previously where Espinoza asked him about a subpoena. Deputy VanAlphen was off work and working in other housing units for several weeks. When Deputy VanAlphen returned to work, which he believed was November 23, 2018, he was assigned to housing unit 6D. Deputy VanAlphen was asked to assist with operational duties in housing units 6B and 6A. When Deputy VanAlphen entered housing 6A via the supply hallway from housing 6B, he observed Lovato at the workstation facing the entry door and Espinoza standing by the stairs leading to the deputy workstation and talking to Lovato. Deputy VanAlphen did not see what was on Lovato's computer screen.

When Espinoza saw VanAlphen, he asked him why he was not allowed 6A anymore and if it was because he was testifying in [REDACTED] case. Espinoza asked Deputy VanAlphen who he was "going to court against" three times. Deputy VanAlphen denied Espinoza's request for information each time. Later, and after Espinoza was in his cell, Deputy VanAlphen was concerned enough about Espinoza's question to ask Lovato how Espinoza would know he was subpoenaed for a criminal case. Lovato seemed concerned and made a comment to the effect of "I don't know, but he seems to be finding out information," and said she did not know how and did not elaborate further.

Deputy VanAlphen had been served a subpoena to testify in the criminal case of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was a currently incarcerated inmate housed in 6A36. Deputy VanAlphen was unsure of the testimony to be provided as he had not written any reports or had involvement in the [REDACTED] case. Deputy VanAlphen speculated that the subpoena may have stemmed from his involvement in a "mail watch" of [REDACTED] mail. Deputy VanAlphen had not publicized his subpoena and there was no reason for Espinoza or anyone else to have known about the subpoena.

Deputy VanAlphen was concerned about the possibility of his personal information having been shared with an inmate or inmates. I explained to Deputy VanAlphen that there were no credible threats to law enforcement personnel, but advised him to be diligent with his safety.

Deputy VanAlphen told me that he had no additional information and I ended the interview after providing him with my business card.
