On 11/28/2018 I was assigned to Module 6D Watch II in the Jefferson County Detention Center.

Shortly after beginning my shift at 1845 hours I was approached by an I/D, who requested he be left anonymous for his safety, who told me he needed to talk to me later in the shift. At approximately 2130 hours the I/D was in the staging area of 6D and informed me that there was heroin being moved through 6D. I removed the I/D from the staging area to an Ad-Seg cell so that I could speak with him privately. As I questioned him further he went on to tell me that he had heard the drugs are coming in through work release and being moved through the jail via the inmate workers and the kitchen.

He continued and informed me that last he heard one ounce of heroin was brought to 6D. He thought the drugs come to 6D first and then are shuffled throughout the level 6 modules by the worker/feeder he identified as Balderas-Campos, Jose (P01084427) housed in cell #05 while he performs his duties feeding the inmates. He informed me that Balderas-Campos was moving the drugs for an individual he called "Droopy" who lived in unit 2 and identified Droopy as the leader of the operation. I was told that when Balderas-Campos leaves the module to remove the tray cart from the level 6 elevator he meets with an inmate using the moniker "Ice" who is a worker in 6A while he is also in the level 6 hallway waiting for tray carts. "Ice" in turn moves the drugs into modules 6A and 6B.

I asked the I/D if there were currently drugs in the module that could be recovered during a search, he replied by saying "they are gone by now you won't find anything". I concluded my interview with the I/D and returned to the workstation

At around 2150 I contacted Specialist Wilder to see if he could check for any individual who used the moniker Droopy. Specialist Wilder informed me that in 6D unit 2 Cell # 29, an I/D identified as Bofill, Joshua (P00193535) used the moniker "Droopy". Wilder also identified "Ice" as Espinosa, Justice (P-1010180) who is assigned as a worker/feeder in 6A.

Based on my interview with this I/D at approximately 2205 hours I contacted Sgt. Whetstone and informed him of my findings. At this point Sgt. Whetstone authorized an Administrative Search of units 1 and 2 specifically the lower tier.

The search began at 0005 hours. The water was shut off in the module and Deputies were split evenly in units 1 and 2. We began removing inmates from unit 1 and 2 simultaneously specifically starting on cells 03, 05, and 07 in unit 1 and cells 25, 27, 29 and 31 in unit 2 to target the cells of Balderas-Campos and Bofill first. Inmates from Unit 1 were placed in the 6D recreational area while inmates from unit 2 were distributed in the level 6 visitation

booths. After the first groups of inmates were removed the second half from unit 1 cells 09, 11, 13 and 15 were removed and unit 2 cells 17, 19, 21 and 23.

I conducted the search of 6D cell 29 housing Bofill and I/D Alvarado, Michael (P01115841). I conducted clothed body searches of both Bofill and Alvarado as they were removed from the unit I then conducted clothed body searches on I/D Green, Dante (P00121241) and I/D Bryant, Freddie (P01045513).

At about 0015 I began searching cell 29 Inside cell 29 I found in excess of 20 books, 2 rings made of string, a cross made of string, a priority mail envelope that had been altered into a tube (for communicating through the toilet), 2 boxes made out of playing cards, ace bandages that had been modified into a pillow as well as about 20 altered JCSO pens and a cup full of oranges in water with a pungent odor. All of these items were disposed of as nuisance contraband. Upon completion of my search in cell 29 I then searched cell 15. I found only nuisance contraband and disposed of these items.

The search was concluded at 0045. Deputies involved in the search debriefed in the level 6 hallway. No drugs were found during the search. At 0050 hours I returned to normal module operations.

After assisting with laundry exchange in module 6A, I was asked to assist in an administrative search in module 6D. I was briefed by Deputy K. Bedford that he has been informed of possible heroin in cell 5 and 29.

At about 0005 hours, I entered 6D unit 2. Three other deputies and I focused on the lower tier of unit 2 while 4 other deputies entered unit 1 lower. I went to cell 27 and conducted clothed body searches of Orona, Paul Larry (JCID# P00118051) and Endicott, Zakaryah (JCID# P01083652). I assisted in searching cells 27 and 25 and found only nuisance contraband which I disposed of per JCSO policy.

After the search was complete, all inmates from the lower tier were returned to their respected cells without an issue.

At about 0045 hours I returned to my normal duties in 5D.

On 11/28/2018 I was assigned as 6 escort of the Jefferson County Detention Facility. At about 2345 hours I was asked to help in an administrative search of the lower cells in Unit's 1 and 2 in Module 6D. Deputy Bedford informed us that he had been given information that there was possible heroin in the two units. From the information that Deputy Bedford received cells 5 and 29 were of interest. Because the 2 cells in question were in different units, it was decided that 4 deputies would enter unit 1 while 4 deputies simultaneously entered unit 2. Both groups of deputies would conduct clothed body searches (pat down) of the inmates housed on the lower tier.

Once the inmates in unit 1 had all been patted down, they were sent to the 6C/D recreation yard. After the inmates in unit 2 had been patted down, they were sent to the level 6 visiting booths.

At about 0005 hours I entered unit 2 and conducted clothed body searches of Harue Aguilar-Acosta (JCID #P-1120105), and Robert Michael Gallegos (JCID#P-129049) who were assigned in cell 31 and also Jackson Devon Chism (JCID # P-189634) and Jacob Reed (JCID # P-1038554) who were assigned in cell 23.

Once all the inmates were removed from unit 2 I searched cell 17 and cell 31 and found only nuisance contraband which was disposed of per JCSO policy.

After the search was concluded all of the inmates returned to their cells without incident and I returned to my assigned duties as 6 escort.

On 112820018 I was assigned to module 6D of the Jefferson County Detention Facility in Golden CO.

At approximatley midnight of 11/27 into 11/28, we began an administrative search of units 1 and 2 lower level cells due to some information that Deputy Bedford had obtianed earlier in the shift about potential contraband in the module. My responsibility was opening doors from the control tower of 6D as other deputies entered the units to conduct the search. I shut the water off in units 1 and 2 as deputies entered the module to prevent any inmates from flushing any contraband prior to the search. I remained in the tower during the search to help coordinate movement of inmate / detainees (I/Ds) and observe any I/Ds that were placed in the module recreation yard during the search. Other inmates were moved into visitation booths in the level 6 hallway during this time.

The search concluded at approximately 0045 hours on 11282018 and all I/Ds were returned to their cells, I then resumed normal operations in 6D.

Deputy Bedford briefed the other deputies and I in Level 6 hallway that we would be searching for drugs, specifically heroin on the lower tiers of Unit 1 and Unit 2. It was decided that the I/Ds housed in Unit 1 would be placed in the 6 C/D recreation yard and the I/Ds housed in Unit 2 would be placed in the visitation booths in the hallway on level 6. I was tasked with placing the I/Ds in the recreation yard and watching them during the duration

of the search.

The other deputies and I entered 6D at 0005 hours with 4 deputies entering Unit 1 and 4 deputies entering Unit 2. Clothed body searches were performed on all I/Ds before sending them to either the recreation yard or hallway. After all I/Ds were placed in the recreation yard I entered the control tower of 6D and watched the I/Ds for any suspicious activity. None was observed.

At approximately 0020 hours the level 6 floor control contacted the workstation in 6D to inform us that the 2 I/Ds in visiting booth 3 had taken the instructions for the voice recognition phone off of the wall and were attempting to hide them in their pants. I left the module and opened the door to visitor booth 3 where I/Ds AGUILAR-ACOSTA, HARUE (JCID # P-1120105) and BOFILL, JOSHUA MATTHEW (JCID # P-193535) were held. I asked them to give me the instructions. Bofill reached in his pants and produced the 2 laminated instructions for the voice recognition phone. I returned to the 6D workstation with the documents.

After the other deputies had completed the search of Unit 1 and Unit 2 I assisted in placing the I/Ds back in their respective units. I also did a search of the recreation yard where the Unit 1 I/Ds were being held and discovered nothing out of the ordinary.

The administrative search was completed at 0045 hours and I returned to my normal duties.
