Dear Ms. Wilson:

The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office accepted the resignation of Deputy Myriah Lovato (P.O.S.T. identification number #5903-2612 effective January 2, 2019. Her resignation was tendered prior to the completion of an Administrative Investigation, as well as a criminal investigation into her actions as a deputy sheriff. While I acknowledge Ms. Lovato's intent to resign, her resignation may be re-characterized as a termination for cause in her personnel file at the conclusion of the pending administrative investigation.

Information obtained during the investigations has raised questions regarding her credibility. The facts giving rise to the inquiry and the nature of the concerns raised by the criminal investigation have prompted the sheriff's office, out of an abundance of caution and pursuant to the United States Supreme Court's decision in *Brady v. Maryland*, 373 U.S. 83 (1963), to inform your agency of the existence of information pertaining to Myriah Lovato that may be considered exculpatory.
