Complaint Narrative

The complainant, Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he called Traffic Operations for a telephone number to the Colorado Bureau of Investigation (CBI). He was told to call the Police Administration Building at X6010. An unknown officer answered the telephone at X6010. The complainant alleges that when he asked for the CBI telephone number, the officer stated that he was too busy and had people in the front lobby. The unknown officer stated to the complainant, "Get a fucking telephone book". The complainant called back a second time and the same officer answered the telephone. When the officer heard the complainant's voice, the officer disconnected the call. Mr. [REDACTED] called the DPD, Communications Bureau and was forwarded to the Internal Affairs Bureau.

The complaint you initiated on October 4, 2004 was received and reviewed by the involved officer's commanders.


