This letter is to serve as an ORAL REPRIMAND for the violation(s) of Rule and Regulations Section 809, which reads as follows:

RR-809 Rough or Careless Handling of City or Departmental Property

Members shall use care in handling department equipment and property, and shall report immediately any that is lost, damaged or in bad order. Any member who willfully or negligently loses, damages, or destroys department property shall be subject to a departmental hearing to determine disposition of such cases.

Your recommendation that the officer receive an Oral Reprimand and attend **Remedial Driver Training** at the Denver Police Academy for this violation has been reviewed and approved.
