As Chief of Police for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, I received information from the Internal Affairs Bureau that on June 28, 2005 you were charged by Adams County with a violation of C.R.S. 18-4-203(1)(2)(a), 2nd Degree Burglary, a Class 3 Felony, with a violation of C.R.S 18-3-203(1)(g), 2nd Degree Assault, a Class 4 Felony and with a violation of C.R.S 18-4-502, a Class 5 Felony.

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 9.4.17 of the Charter of the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, you are hereby suspended from duty, without pay, effective June 28, 2005, for an indefinite period of time until further order.

It is further ordered that pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief of Police, your authority to carry a weapon as a member of the Classified Service of the Denver Police Department is hereby suspended until further order.

COUNT 1-SECOND DEGREE BURGLARY (F-3)
