

This letter is to inform you that the Denver Police Department (DPD) is contemplating disciplinary action against you for violations of the DPD Operations Manual. The actions described below may have violated the following policies or procedures:

RR-102 Violation of any Department Rule

Officers shall obey all departmental rules, duties, procedures, instructions, or orders, and the provisions of the Operations Manual.

As it pertains to:

105.07(5) Firearms Proficiency

a. All officers of the Denver Police Department are required to shoot once during each shoot period and achieve a passing score on the course of fire specified by the Firearms Bureau.

Disciplinary Recommendation by Division Chief Timothy Cuthriell, 70183: Fined 1 day and Remedial Firearms Training.

This action is based upon the following information. This is not intended to be a complete summary of the case file.

During Shoot Period 2 of 1997, Officer Todd Rounph failed to shoot for proficiency. Internal Affairs Bureau records indicate Officer Todd Rounph has 1 failure to shoot within the past twelve consecutive months.
