This letter is to serve as an ORAL REPRIMAND for the violation(s) of Rules and Regulations Section 809, which reads as follows:


**RR-809 ROUGH OR CARELESS HANDLING OF CITY OR DEPARTMENTAL

Any members who willfully or negligently loses, damages, or destroys department property shall be subject to a departmental hearing to determine disposition of such cases."

Your recommendation that the officer receive an Oral Reprimand for this violation has been reviewed and approved.
