I reviewed the documentation from both Trooper Wermuth and [REDACTED] I believe that Trooper Wermuth went above and beyond with this party. We found nothing that substantiated the reporting party's accusations of Trooper Wermuth being dismissive, the RP being profiled, as she had been involved in a crash he investigated, she was not stopped by the trooper, or that he was "a bully".
