## AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF WARRANTLESS ARREST

I, Officer Jackson Mill FI25-03 being duly sworn and upon oath says that there is probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named Defendant for the charge(s) stated above, and that the following facts are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, and support the arrest of the Defendant, Shane Andrew Sloan

Your Affiant, Jackson Mill, is a sworn peace officer for the Firestone Police Department and has gained the following information by reading the reports of fellow officers, the statements of the victim and witnesses, and through personal investigation.

On November 25th, 2025, at approximately 1:53pm, your affiant responded to a call regarding a disturbance at 138 Florence Ave, in the Town of Firestone, County of Weld, State of Colorado.

While on scene officers knocked on the door of the residence to which a male could be heard from inside who was later identified as the defendant. Officers made announcements for the defendant to open the door to which he refused. The sound of a woman crying and yelling could be heard from inside the residence. Officers gave the defendant multiple warnings to open the door or it would be forced open.


The defendant stood at the door and talked to officers through it stating nothing happened inside and everything was ok. After a final warning officers attempted to force entry into the residence due to the exigent circumstances of the woman inside giving signs of distress. The front door was hit with a ram two times before the defendant agreed to open it.

Once the door opened the defendant exited the residence and was placed into custody for obstruction while officers collected more information on what happened inside of the house.

The defendant stated he did not want to speak with officers without a lawyer. It was determined that only a verbal argument between the defendant and his wife took place inside the residence.

Based on the statements provided and the physical evidence observed, Officers determined that probable cause existed to arrest the defendant for obstruction.

The defendant was arrested on the above charges and booked into the Weld County Jail without incident.




