AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF WARRANTLESS ARREST

I, Officer Jackson Mill FI25-03 being duly sworn and upon oath says that there is probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named Defendant for the charge(s) stated above, and that the following facts are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, and support the arrest of the Defendant, Shane Andrew Sloan

Your Affiant, Jackson Mill, is a sworn peace officer for the Firestone Police Department and has gained the following information by reading the reports of fellow officers, the statements of the victim and witnesses, and through personal investigation.

On January 30th, 2026, at approximately 04:33am, your affiant responded to a call regarding an assault at 138 Florence Ave, in the Town of Firestone, County of Weld, State of Colorado.

While on scene, officers knocked on the door of the residence to which a female answered the door who was later identified as the victim Justine Sloan DOB: 10/31/1987. Officers spoke with the victim, to which she stated the defendant hit her. She identified the defendant as Shane Sloan DOB: 08/11/1988.

The victim told officers the defendant and her were in an argument that started due to the victim confronting the defendant about him cheating on her. The victim said the defendant had grown very angry about the confrontation and started to hit her multiple times.

The victim stated she was hit by the defendant with an open hand multiple times in the face, pulled by her hair, and kicked while she was on the ground. The victim stated these strikes caused her physical pain and gave her a migraine. Officers observed the victim had noticeable markings on her lower right eye lid and her left elbow. Photos of the injuries were taken on scene and uploaded to evidence. The victim also stated that the defendant hits her with an open hand because he knows it does less damage and doesn't show marks.

The victim advised officers that incidents similar to this have happened multiple times in the past but have not been reported. The victim stated she is tired of the abuse. She stated it isn't fair to her [REDACTED]

While on scene, officers spoke with [REDACTED] who stated she had heard the incident taking place and had walked to the master bedroom where the victim and the defendant were fighting. She descreatly recorded a brief portion of the altercation that showed the defendant strike the victim with an open had slap. Officers reviewed this footage and observed the victim state to the defendant that she would call the police. The defendant then told the victim to do it because she would be the one who would be arrested. After the defendant said this, he then slapped the victim in the face causing the victim to fall onto the bed.

When the victim was asked if [REDACTED] were present during the altercation she said she was unsure due to trying to protect herself from the defendant. She did state that after the altercation [REDACTED] were standing outside the bedroom in the hallway. It was later confirmed that [REDACTED] were both standing outside the bedroom during the altercation.

It was determined that the victim and the defendant were in an intimant relationship.

On 01/30/2026, at approximately 10:25am, officers were in contact with the defendant and his lawyer. It was explained to them that there were charges against Shane and the Firestone Police were looking for him. The defendant and his lawyer went back and forth with officers on what the defendant should do to turn himself in. An agreement was made that the defendant would turn himself into the Firestone Police Department later in the day.

At approximately 20:21 the defendant arrived to the Firestone Police Department and was taken into custody. The defendant stated he did not wish to speak with officer's about the case. The defendant was then transported to the Weld County Jail.

Based on the statements provided and the physical evidence observed, Officers determined that probable cause existed to arrest the defendant for the above listed charges.
